Home Ec House At OSC Out

PORTLAND—(P)—A proposed home management house on the Oregon State College campus has been abandoned for the present as too costly.

The State Board of Higher Education rejected all three bids at a special meeting called here to consider building plans. The estimate for the house was \$65,000, of which only \$58,000 was for actual construction. The three bids opened ranged from \$80,800 to \$89,000 for construction alone.

The board awarded a contract to Warren Construction Co., Portland, for paying .75 of a mile of streets and a number of sidewalks on the Oregon State campus. The firm's \$51,877 bid was well within the estimate. Final approval of the contract must be given by the State Board of Control and the State Emergency Board.

Forest Fire Warning Cards to Fall From Sky

SOEUR d'Alene, Idaho—(P)—Fire danger warning cards will flutter down from the sky this summer to warn visitors to the Coeur d'Alene National Forest of extreme fire hazards, a forest service official said today.

Walter A. LaFon of the Coeur d'Alene forest staff said a fire patrol plane would drop white cards carrying this message:

"Fire danger now severe. Special care with fire by everyone is most important."

Commission Urges Rezoning Rejection

Recommendations that two rezoning applications be denied will be forwarded to the city council as the result of Tuesday night's meeting of the City Planning Commission.

The commission made its decisions after hearing both petitions protested by parties who would be affected were the rezonings granted.

Jewell A. Newbury had asked for light industrial reclassification of single-family residential property on Fillmore St. between Seventh and Eighth Aves.

The other petition was filed by Charles A. Dickinson concerning property at 2280 Eighteenth Ave. W., which he wanted rezoned from single-family residential to the limited business category.

The planning commission also discussed the problem of developing an arterial street system in the city and proposed an early meeting with the City Airport Commission to discuss mutual problems.

A plan for renumbering and renaming streets in the newly-annexed sections in the South Willamette St. areas also was discussed and will be forwarded to the city council at its July 12 meeting.
