Tourists Report Swell Time; But Supervisor Says Different

LEWISTON, Idaho —(AP)—Four tourists who finished a boat trip down the Lochsa River on foot and a road supervisor who picked them up at the end of their trail gave somewhat different versions of how tough the jaunt was. William Porter, Jr., said in Spokane after the boat trip, his party had a "marvelous time" and suffered no major hardships despite losing a rubber boat on the river. M. D. Bradshaw, supervisor of the Public Roads Administration, who picked up the party Monday at the Lochsa ranger station, said all he knew about the trip was what the travelers told him, but added, "they only brought one small knapsack out with them."

Previous news stories had indicated erroneously that the party had capsized in the swift river. Porter said the boat was lost as the party was lowering it with ropes through the rapids but "there was no one in it at the time and all our provisions were safely on shore."

Mr. and Mrs. Porter, W. W. Powell, Jr., and Miss Sally Paine left the Powell ranger station near the Idaho-Montana border in their boat Saturday morning. Porter said they lost the boat

about noon Sunday. They walked downriver the rest of the day, camped overnight and walked all day Monday before reaching the Lochsa ranger station, Porter said. He said the party "had lots of food and blankets, and no mosquito bothered us." Bradshaw said he didn't know about that, but he added shoes and clothing were muddy. It looked like a rough trip.

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
