FORT WORTH, Tex., July 7—
The National Federation of
Business and Professional Women's
Clubs convention Wednesday de-
cided to ask Democratic party
leaders to include an equal rights
amendment in the 1948 party plat-
form.

A voice vote carried on a mo-
tion to send a telegram to the
Democratic leaders meeting Thurs-
day in Philadelphia to draft the
party platform.

Delegates to the convention here
also agreed to send separate tele-
grams to the central committee
members of every state.

The motion was placed before
the convention by Judge Sarah T.
Hughes, Dallas. The Republican
party was commended by dele-
gates for its equal rights amend-
ment stand.
