New Law for Veteran's Training Appears Less Than Rumored

Public law 882, intended to prohibit the Veterans Administration from expending government funds for educational and recreational study and training, may not be quite as stringent as earlier reports have indicated.

Neither the Eugene veterans office nor the University of Oregon have had any official reports from the administrative officials on specific training affected by the new law. Unofficial information would tend to indicate a less restricted policy than originally expected.

Locally, the more seriously affected will be ex-GIs planning flight training. Certified flight schools, properly doing their job, will continue to receive VA approval. But prospective students must now show reasonable justification that the flight training is in connection with present or contemplated work.

Prior to July 1, when the law came into effect, an eligibility certificate virtually assured the veteran of flight training acceptance, even though he only wanted to learn to fly for a hobby.

Veterans who have gone to Portland seeking clarification of the new VA ruling in order to enroll in flight-training courses, have found the officials almost as befuddled by the new ruling as outsiders.

Neglected Tots Aided By Court

SAN FRANCISCO—A five-year-old Sharon Stewart, who was found locked in a filthy closet while her mother picked up on a fishing trip, was taken from her parents Friday, along with her brother and sister.

The three children, Sharon, Judy, 3, and Michael, 6, were made wards of the juvenile court and ordered placed in foster homes. Juvenile court referees Helen Block held their parents were "totally inadequate and unfit" to care for them.

Three weeks ago, juvenile authorities entered the Stewart home and found Sharon cringing in a dark closet. She was naked and filthy. Her mother admitted she had locked the girl up in that way 15 or 20 times during the last year as "punishment."

Sharon was taken to San Francisco Hospital where she was found to be 15 pounds underweight and suffering from malnutrition. She still is a patient at the hospital.

Abuse Reported
Ten neighbors testified in Thursday's hearing that Sharon had been subjected to abuse. One said she had seen Sharon locked out of the house for a whole day. She saw the girl eat breakfast out of the garbage can.

The parents still face charges of cruel and inhuman treatment. They are out on \$2500 bail each.
