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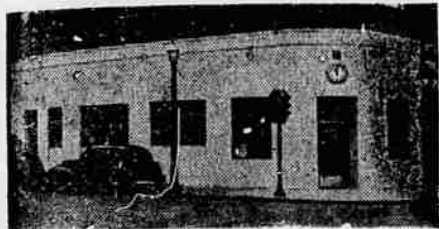
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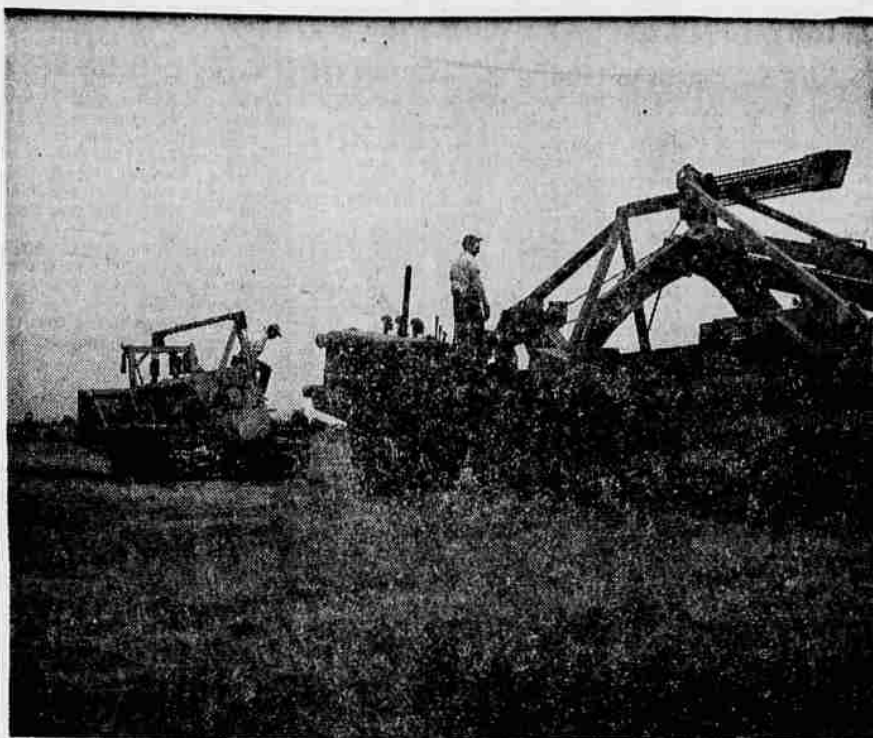

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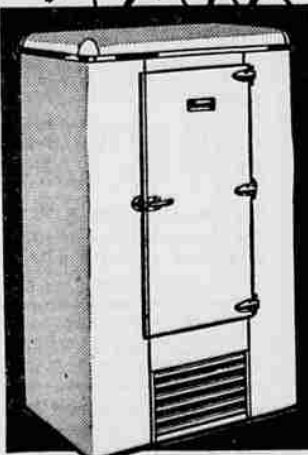
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Gleemen Name New Officers

The meeting was held as a squash dinner at the G. E. Gaylord home.



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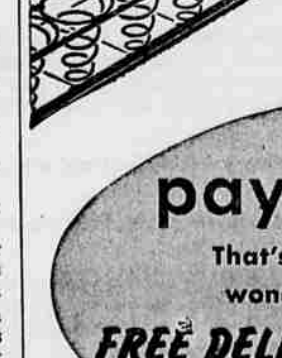
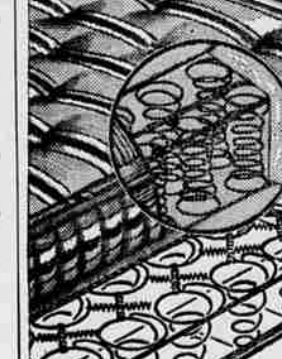
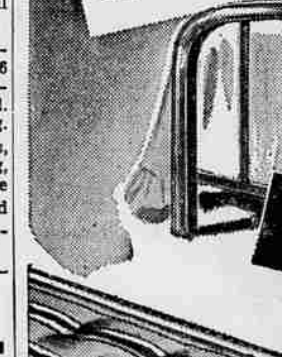
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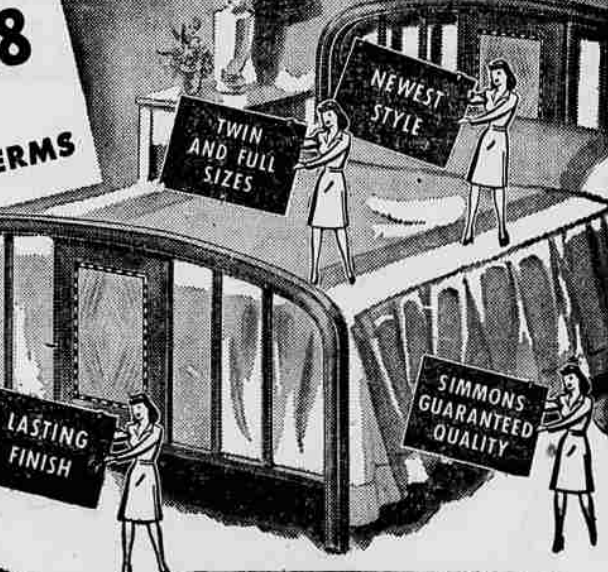
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
