

University GPA Turns Upward

The "all-university" grade point average for spring term took a slight upturn over the average for winter and fall terms, according to a report on grades released Tuesday by the registrar's office at the University of Oregon. Spring term all-campus average was 2.461, as against 2.45 for winter term, and 2.353 for fall term of the past school year. Averages are based on a system that qualifies A as 4.000, B as 3.00, and C as 2.00.

Men's clubs made the highest average of the undergraduate groups for the spring term with 2.67, followed by non-organization women with 2.64. Women's clubs averaged 2.571, all women averaged 2.520, women's sororities made 2.497, non-organization men made 2.454, men's dormitories averaged 2.447, women's dormitories averaged 2.4403, all men averaged 2.431, and men's fraternities 2.367.

Leading the house grade list was women's sorority, Pi Beta Phi, with 2.77. University House, women's cooperative, was second with a 2.736, and Delta Gamma, women's sorority, third with 2.731. Fourth on the list was Tau Kappa Epsilon, men's fraternity, with 2.71.

Officer's Death Under Query

SEATTLE—U.P.—Coroner John P. Brill Wednesday ordered an autopsy to determine the cause of death of a Fort Lewis Army officer whose blanket-wrapped body was found on the Flaming Geysers road between Enumclaw, Wash., and Black Diamond Tuesday night.

The body of Capt. Gale Finley, fully clothed, was discovered by a blackberry picker, lying near the Army officer's 1941 Lincoln coupe. Brill said the man apparently had been dead for about a week. Capt. Finley had been missing from the fort since July 5.

There was no evidence that the officer, about 30 years of age, had met a violent death.

Brill said the captain's widow lived in California.
