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Increasing British-American Solidarity Seen in World Crisis

One of the outstanding aspects of the current international crisis is the increasing American-British solidarity—a solidarity which forms the backbone of the bloc of Democratic nations.

We get a striking demonstration of this in the coordination of effort being displayed in the battle of Berlin. We see it again in the way London has veered around to the Washington viewpoint that the United Nations should use strong methods to halt the war in the Holy Land.

Several Factors
This intensification of unity is due to numerous factors. But foremost is recognition that it is essential for the defense of democracy against Bolshevik aggression which aims at world conquest.

Then, too, there is a mutual respect for integrity and ability to deliver the goods in emergencies. I'm reminded of a remark made to me the other day in a New York subway by a young Englishman—a stranger to me—who was trying desperately to figure out how to reach his destination.

"Must Be Right!"
"I don't see how you folk ever get anywhere," he said gloomily, "but you always seem to arrive, so I suppose you must be right."

That was a backhanded compliment to the U.S.A. It was almost identical with what I've heard

Englishmen say of their own country innumerable times:
"We British have an extraordinary faculty for muddling things up—but some way we always manage to muddle through."

It's true that Americans frequently do "arrive" and that Britons as often "muddle through." Both countries recognize this quality in the other, and respect it. And if each also recognizes it in itself, what's wrong with that?

So it isn't strange that King George VI, in addressing the American and other bishops attending the Lambeth Conference in London should appeal for close collaboration between the United States and Britain to assure world peace. We may not be able to maintain peace, but the consensus of observers seems to be that such collaboration will contribute more towards it than will anything else.

New Party Files For Foreign Vote

SALEM — (P) — The "Progressive" Party banner has been revived by Henry A. Wallace followers in Oregon who have filed petitions to get the new party on the November ballot.

Name of the party whose ticket will be headed by Former Vice-President Wallace and Senator Glenn Taylor of Idaho was listed on the petitions submitted to the State Election Division Tuesday as the Progressive Party of Oregon.

Nels Peterson, Portland attorney and chairman of the Wallace for President Committee, said a state convention will be held in Portland Saturday and Sunday. The assembly will name candidates for state office, adopt a state platform and designate delegates to the national convention in Philadelphia July 25-26.

An estimated half of approximately 20,000 petition signers are from Multnomah County and 1804 from Marion County. The Eastern Oregon area was less well represented. Only 820 names from the Second Congressional District were on the formal petition.

At the same time the petitions were being filed, an invitation was issued labor and other groups to send delegates to the convention. Soon afterward, James A. Marr, secretary of the AFL State Federation of Labor, said "this is an insult."

British Plane Falls With 20 On Board

PARIS — (P) — A twin-engine British passenger plane carrying 20 persons crashed Wednesday on Cape Sicile, near Toulon, the French Press Agency reported.

In London, British overseas airways officials said one of their twin-engine Dakotas was overdue at Marseilles, but emphasized that the plane carried only freight and no passengers.

Pilots Accept Findings

CHICAGO — (P) — The Air Line Pilots Assn. (ALP) Wednesday announced acceptance of a presidential fact-finding board's recommendations to end a six-week strike against national airlines.

David L. Behncke, president of the union, said that the strike will not end until the company also accepts the terms.

REAL POLISH UNDERGROUND

WARSAW — (P) — Poles claim to have found a tunnel running under the Vistula river from the heart of Warsaw to suburban Praga. It is believed to have been built during the Polish uprising against the Russians in 1943 but apparently never was used.

Ferry Street Revetment Planned by Engineers

PORTLAND — (P) — Revetment repairs on the Willamette River are planned in Lane and Linn counties by the Corps of Engineers.

Bids will be opened Aug. 3 on repairs to the revetment at Ferry Street bridge and Upper Goodpasture in Lane County, with the work to be completed within 60 days of notice to proceed.

Bids on repairs at Jacobs Bend seven miles northwest of Halsey in Linn County will be opened July 30. Sixty days is allotted for the work.

Aviation Experts Meet

SEATTLE, Wash. — (P) — Aviation experts from 13 countries Wednesday began discussions aimed at framing one set of basic procedures for international flight operations throughout the world.

Government officials, military men and advisers will concentrate on the air route between the North and Alaska, the Orient, New Zealand and Australia.

Jets Resume Pioneer Flight

BANGOR, Me. — (P) — Two jet fighter planes hopped from Dow Base Wednesday to join 14 others waiting at Goose Bay, Labrador to resume a pioneer West-East Trans-Atlantic flight.

The 14 other ships of the 56th fighter group made the 714-mile flight from Bangor to Goose Bay in two hours Monday.

Good weather was reported all the way to Goose Bay when the two planes left Dow Base at 6:48 a. m. (PDT).

The American planes are bound to Germany via Greenland, Iceland, Scotland and England.

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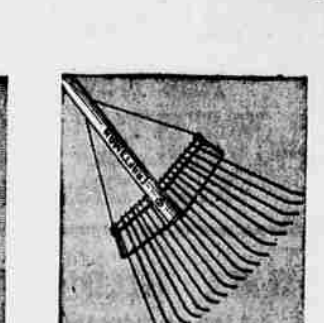
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
