

Two Hospitalized In Wreck Near Lake

A car and motorcycle collision west of Eugene near Fern Ridge Lake at 9:30 p.m. Thursday hospitalized two persons, state police reported.

Injured were William Baker, 27, 609 Fourth Ave. W., Eugene, who was riding a motorcycle toward Eugene, and Sharon Powers, 7, a passenger in a car driven toward Veneta by Lester Anstine, of Veneta.

Officers said the little girl had her arm out the window, and was holding a balloon when the motorcycle swerved and crashed against the car. She suffered arm injuries, but her doctor could not be reached Friday morning for a statement.

Both she and Baker were taken to Sacred Heart Hospital, where Baker's condition was reported good Friday.

McKenzie River Communities Secure Waste Disposal Sites

County Senior Sanitarian Victor C. Morgan reported Friday upper McKenzie River communities had taken the initiative in providing improved refuse disposal and sanitary facilities for their neighborhoods in recent weeks.

He said that two new community dump sites have been secured and are in operation as a part of the program to keep the river and adjacent areas free from refuse and garbage.

At a meeting this week of the McKenzie River Protective and Development Assn., headed by Carl R. Baker of Vida, Morgan and Kenneth Spies of the state sanitary engineering department discussed continued policing of the river by local groups.

Spies reviewed present Oregon laws that prohibit dumping refuse near the McKenzie and told the association that the state could offer some help in enforcing the laws. Violators are prosecuted through the local courts, and can be arrested by local authorities on complaints signed by private citizens.

Morgan reported that the McKenzie organization was one of the most active of its type in the state, and that it was hoped that other Lane communities would be able to set up similar groups to solve community disposal problems.

He cited Florence, Mapleton, Oakridge, Cottage Grove, and other communities as needing community effort to clean up the rubbish problem along roads and streams.

A county-wide committee was established early this year which included civic leaders from all of these areas, Morgan said, and it will conduct a tour of possible dump locations and improvements in the near future, with county officials and representatives from the state sanitary section of the state board of health.

Six applicants participated in Thursday's civil service exams for fire department positions, and one man tried the qualifying tests for the police department.

Henry Beistel, city recorder and secretary of the civil service commission, reported Friday that a larger number of applicants had filed to take the exams, but only these seven actually participated.

Thursday morning the men were given written exams. In the afternoon they took part in athletic tryouts.

Their scores will be compiled by the state civil service commission at Salem, Beistel said, and should be available in about 10 days.

Those who passed them will be given oral interviews before the city civil service commission and will need to present completed medical examination forms.

When finally rated on the civil service certified list of candidates, the men will be in position to obtain jobs in the two city departments with starting pay of \$220 a month.

Readjustment allowances paid to unemployed veterans during the coming week may be delayed slightly because of moving check processing operations from Portland to Salem, the State Unemployment Compensation Commission announced Friday.
