

Question-Do Foreign Communist Delegations Threaten American?

The question before the House is whether a Red not a Red, or Communists who are bent on mischief always give warning by displaying the Red danger signal?

It's an ironic circumstance—though perhaps not strange—that while twelve top leaders of the U. S. Communist Party were being indicted on charges of advocating the overthrow of the Washington government by force there should also arise the pressing query of whether foreign Communist delegations in the United Nations are a threat to American security. There is a divergence of testimony regarding the Bolsheviks attached to the peace organization.

Officials Testify

Last week two State Department officials testified before a Senate judiciary subcommittee that hundreds of foreign agents may be operating subversively in the United States on U. N. credentials. The officials were Robert U. Alexander, assistant chief of the State Department visa division, and William Harlow, chief of the department's diplomatic visa section.

Douglas Fir Cut Increased

Sawmills in the Douglas fir region of Oregon and Washington during the first six months of 1948 produced 37 million board feet of lumber in excess of the amount produced during the same period last year.

A total of 4,109,429,000 bd. ft. have been produced so far this year, according to H. V. Simpson, vice president of West Coast Lumbermen's Assn. However, June weekly averages were below May totals because of the flood conditions.

Principal concern to lumbermen on the West Coast today is the possibility of a freight car shortage in the late summer, Simpson said. He was confident that 1948 would see adequate production of Douglas fir and hemlock to meet all requirements.

First-Time Students Must Have Physicals

Parents of children entering either the first or ninth grades this fall, and parents of children starting school for the first time in Oregon were reminded Thursday to have their child's health certificate completed early, in order to avoid a rush to already-busy doctors during the first part of September.

County School Superintendent Lucille L. Klinge said that the physical examinations can be given by the family doctor at any

time before school starts. Certificates of such examination are required by law for all new students. The rule applies to Eugene city schools as well as to all other public schools in the county.
