World Affairs, the sponsoring organization, at 27 E. Broadway.

The doors will open at 7 p. m. Monday night and will close at 8:20.

Glenn Gregory, acting chairman of the council, said Friday that McArthur Court will seat more than 8000 persons, and the sponsoring organization hopes that every seat will be taken.

The topic: "How Should the United Nations Progressively Establish International Law?" is particularly timely, Gregory pointed out.

In view of the growing tension in the world, and fear that the world will be allowed to drift into another war, Gregory said, "It is a privilege for the people of Lane County to hear four experts on international affairs discuss the establishment of a body of law that will protect the world's people from wars they don't want."

Fry has contended that the peace can be kept, "if the people care enough." In an article published in London last year, Fry wrote, "Peace is the people's business. They must attend to it with courage. . . or go out of business for good."

The Eugene Council, in sponsoring the nation-wide radio forum, felt that the nation's leaders would act according to the wishes of the people, if they know what the people want.

"Town Meeting," said Gregory, "is one of the ways we can learn, hear all sides of a question, make up our minds, and then tell our governing officials."

Wallace Party Sessions Start

nominated Saturday afternoon, will take from the Democrats enough votes in the big population states to clinch the election of their nominee, Gov. Thomas E. Dewey of New York.

Demos Whistle

The Democrats whistle valiantly that Wallace, a former New Dealer, will lure as many votes away from the GOP as he does from their party.

Meanwhile, Albert J. Fitzgerald, chosen as permanent chairman of the convention, said that labor representatives from every state are represented on a national labor committee supporting Wallace and Taylor.

Fitzgerald listed 47 AFL unions, 31 CIO groups, 14 railroad brotherhoods and six independent unions as having membership on the Wallace labor committee.

1000 Labor Men

He said there will be 1000 members of the group of labor leaders supporting the Wallace-Taylor ticket.

The pesky fly in the Third Party ointment was the Communists that opponents said were calling the signals for the Wallace-Taylor movement.

This charge, voiced by the Americans for Democratic Action — an aggregation of former New Dealers — provoked Dr. Rexford Guy Tugwell into a statement that the assertion was an "unscrupulous and demagogic denunciation worthy of only the cheapest politics — insincere, hypocritical and immaterial."

Tugwell, ex-Roosevelt brain trustee who heads the new party's 74-member platform committee, got cheers from the Wallaceites as he denounced charges made by James L. Loeb Jr., ADA executive secretary.

Long Platform

He said the 6500-word document — longest of any yet written in this convention-ridden city — advocates ditching the Marshall

Plan and the Truman doctrine of aid to Greece and Turkey.

It proposes an even stronger civil rights program than those okayed by the Republican and Democratic conventions and plumps for the vote for 18-year-olds.

At convention headquarters, it was announced that Fred Stover of Hampton, Iowa, has been given the much-sought honor of making the nominating speech for Wallace. He is a farmer and long-time friend of Wallace.

The convention opens at 8:30 p. m. Friday night. Charles Howard, Des Moines, Iowa, Negro attorney, will make the keynote address then. Nominating speeches and the formal selection of the Wallace-Taylor ticket comes Saturday.

Jet Fighters Fly to Germany

ODIHAM, Eng. — Sixteen American F-80 Shooting Star jet fighters will leave Saturday for military maneuvers of undisclosed nature in Germany.

The jets will land at Furstentfeldbruck Field near Munich, completing a 5000-mile flight that began at Selfridge Field, Michigan, July 12.

The flight commander, Lt. Col. David Schilling, said the jets would stay in the American zone of Germany for at least two weeks.

Floating Tunnel Seen for Seattle

SEATTLE—A floating steel and concrete tunnel nearly three miles long, to bear four lanes of vehicular traffic, estimated at 10,000,000 cars annually, was envisioned here Friday as "the only type of structure possible" to link Seattle with the Olympic Peninsula across Puget Sound.

An expenditure of fifty to fifty-five million dollars for this engineering solution would be fully justified by time saved for those now using slow and costly ferries and by the resulting future development and property values that would accrue, Charles E. Andrew, chief consulting engineer, Washington Toll Bridge Authority, declared in a paper read at the Summer Convention of the American Society of Civil Engineers. He spoke before the structural division of the 95-year-old Society, oldest national engineering organization in the country, at one of nine technical sessions marking the four-day convention being attended by some 500 civil engineers in the Olympic Hotel.

Upward lift of the tube, the top of which would be 50 feet below the water's surface, would be resisted by live load anchors weighing 500 to 600 tons each and resting on soft bottom material in water depths as great as 800 feet. Mr. Andrew said, "The anchorage principle, he said, 'simulates the sole fish which can lie on the bottom for long periods in swift tides with no appreciable scour occurring.' He described construction methods contemplated, de-

tailing how water would be admitted into sections as finished to sink them to the desired depths, and told of 30,000-ton floating fenders to be used in guarding against ship collision with ventilating towers called for in the project.

after they had killed the last two of their seven victims, farmer James Smith, 25, of Tiffin, who was slain as he sat in a car with his wife, and another man tentatively identified as Glenn Beard Gschwind, a 24-year-old Navy veteran of Fremont, whose body was found early Friday in a roadside park.

The gray Pontiac car in which the killers launched their career 14 days ago by slaying Earl Ambrose, Columbus tavern operator, was found beside Gschwind's body.

Bloody Trail

After the Ambrose killing, the two youthful gunmen blazed a bloody trail, which had law enforcement officers baffled and had all of Ohio in a state of "jitters."

Next on the list of victims was Frank Kerech, middle-aged tour-

ist camp operator at Flat Rock, Mich.
Then the killers, after being seen momentarily in southeastern Ohio, swept into the northern section and back to the Mansfield reformatory where both had served time for previous crimes.

Bielbe Family

There, before dawn, they routed a reformatory official, his wife and 21-year-old daughter from their beds in their nightclothes.

ransacked the residence to obtain a shotgun, rifle and revolver, then shot the three to death in a rain-swept cornfield. The body of reformatory farm superintendent John Bielbe, 50, wife, Nollanda, 52, and 21-year-old Phyllis, were found hours later.
