Working Accident Kills Alsea Logger

The death of Darrell J. Cain, an employee of the Cliper Lumber Co., Alsea, was reported to Lane County Coroner Phil Bartholomew yesterday by the Benton county coroner's office.

Frank H. Warner, Benton coroner, reported that he was called to investigate the death of Cain in a logging accident which occurred near the Lane county line.

Warner said Cain had lived at the logging camp with his wife, Fern. He was working in the woods at 8 p.m. when a log struck him.

The body was taken to the Coroner's Funeral Home in Corvallis. A full report will be filed with the Lane county coroner.

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School Board Lets Contracts

The Eugene School Board this week awarded contracts to the C. P. Tillman Co. and the Graybar Electric Co. for furnishing of fluorescent light fixtures to be installed in several city schools.

Each firm will supply 100 fixtures at unit prices of \$20.25 and \$20.65, respectively.

Also let at the same meeting were contracts for the school system's fuel supply for the next school year.

The Gustafson Fuel Co. was given an order for 255 cords of slab wood; crude oil contracts for 4000 gallons were divided between Manerud-Huntington Fuel Co. and the Central Heating Co.; the latter two firms also will participate with the Rexius Fuel Service in supplying 1800 units of screened sawdust, and the Gustafson Co. will deliver 15,000 gallons of diesel and stove oil.

Other actions of the school board included issuance of an invitation to Architect Graham Smith to meet with the board Aug. 9 for the purpose of completing discussion of a contract for designing the city's proposed new high school.

The board also approved the vacation of a 30-foot strip running along the west side of the new Westmoreland school site. This land will be dedicated to the public as part of the right-of-way for the extension of City view St.

Consolidation Vote Results Not Complete

Results were incomplete Wednesday on a proposal voted on Tuesday to consolidate two rural school districts with Junction City grade school district 69.

Junction City voters approved both measures which would add Goldson and Crown Point to their district but Crown Point voters turned the proposal down 19 to 11.

The county school office had not been able to obtain the results of the vote in Goldson Wednesday.

The Junction City vote was 11 for and 7 against on each measure.

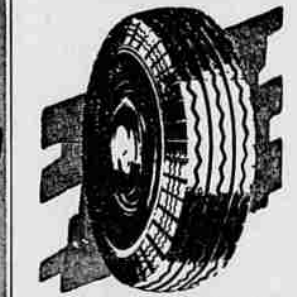
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
