Bumper Wheat Crop Overflows

PENDLETON — (AP) — Wheat was being piled on the ground at Echo Monday as Eastern Oregon's bumper crop began overflowing available storage space.

Many dealers throughout the area began clearing level ground near their elevators as the harvest neared a peak in the lighter land areas of West Umatilla and Morrow Counties. Farmers in these areas reported yields were running 10 bushels or more an acre above average.

"Tightest" storage situation was reported in the Pilot Rock, Ione, Alpine, Sand Hollow and Lexington areas where combines were working at full speed.

The boxcar supply was reported "fair" by most dealers but Lee Mead, Union Pacific Railroad agent here, said the situation would "tighten in about 10 days."

Storage space was practically exhausted in the Echo area where the flour mill started piling wheat on the ground Friday.

Farmers in that area were averaging about 28 bushels an acre. They said this was somewhat below expected yields, however.

Pendleton Grain Growers reported its elevator at Umatilla was filling rapidly but officials of the co-op said rail and barge shipments were expected to keep it from overflowing.

Pendleton elevators had little wheat in them yet. The harvest has just started in this area.

Lexington dealers reported ground dumping would start there in two or three days. They reported shipping difficulties and said only about 150,000 bushels of storage space remained.

Heppner dealers also said ground dumping would start early next week.

Preacher, Student Facing Charges

ATLANTA — (AP) — A 45-year-old Baptist preacher and one of his former missionary students faces a preliminary hearing in recorder's court on a charge of living in adultery.

The two were booked as the Rev. D. A. Martin, a Greenville, S. C., minister for more than 20 years, and Miss Lois Chandler, an attractive 27-year-old brunette.

City electives M. W. Blackwell and Roy Pendley said the minister admitted he and Miss Chandler were the parents of a baby, which they left on the doorstep of his brother-in-law's house, before leaving Greenville in March, 1947.

"They could not have children and I thought they would like it," the detectives quoted Martin.

Martin also left a wife, a 22-year-old son and an 18-year-old daughter in Greenville, according to the detectives.

Tri-State Walnut Agreement Set

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The Agriculture Department has announced a new marketing agreement, effective Aug. 1, for handling walnuts grown in California, Oregon and Washington.

The program will replace one which has been in effect since 1935, except for the war years. Its purpose is to simplify administrative procedure. Walnut producers and handlers have approved the new agreement.

Cannery Vote Set for August

Union shop elections at Eugene Fruit Growers Assn. have been tentatively set for Aug. 3 in Eugene and Aug. 4 in Junction City, the AF of L local cannery workers' union reported Tuesday.

Union Business Manager Mrs. Alice Bissell said a representative of the National Labor Relations Board would be in Eugene Wednesday to set the definite election date.

Union shop elections are required by the Taft-Hartley Law to determine if unions which have union shop clauses, shall be entitled to keep them. Because of the pending elections, local cannery workers will discuss the issue as a special order of business at 8 p. m. Wednesday at Carpenters' Hall in Eugene.

Union members at Junction City will discuss the issue during a meeting at 8 p. m. Thursday at Greenwood Hall in their city.

Mrs. Bissell noted Tuesday that members called for work should clear through the union the day before they report for work. Cannery union offices are located at the plants, as well as at 507 Willamette St. in Eugene.

Furniture Market Opens in Los Angeles

LOS ANGELES — (AP) — The Los Angeles furniture market opened its 22nd annual session here with 5000 registered dealers from across the nation gathered for a glimpse of the latest California designs.

Anticipating a trade volume near the record-breaking \$167,000,000 of last year, more than 300 furniture manufacturers displayed modern and period furniture, appliances, lamps, floor coverings, art, giftware and other goods.

High in popularity this year are French provincial and colonial styles. Market officials said the two periods will have their largest display in the history of the Los Angeles market.

Most of the eastern buyers, however, indicated much interest in California contemporary designs that have focused national attention on Los Angeles.

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Powers Finish Text Of Reply to Soviets

LONDON — (AP) — The United States, Great Britain and France Tuesday completed the text of their reply to Russia on Berlin and reached an agreement on long range strategy for dealing with Soviet political aggression.
