Berlin Impasse Waits New Bid From Moscow

Ministers Confer
Soon With Molotov

WASHINGTON.—(AP)—Authoritative sources reported Thursday that the next major diplomatic development on the Berlin impasse probably will come sometime next week from Moscow.

Informants predicted that it would be several days at least before any agreement bearing on the Berlin blockade would be forthcoming from the Soviet capital where the next western moves are scheduled to be made.

Under presently-planned strategy, the American, British and French ambassadors in Moscow soon will ask for permission to discuss the Berlin dispute face-to-face with Soviet Foreign Minister V. M. Molotov. Molotov's reply to the request, and the prospect of ensuing negotiations were said to preclude any definite agreement on the impasse by this weekend.

Chemical Plant Blast Kills 3 in West Virginia

NEMOURS, W. Va.—(AP)—An explosion ripped through the E. I. du Pont de Nemours and Co. plant here Friday. Plant Manager T. A. O'Barr said three workers were killed.

He said the explosion occurred in a small building used for pressing black powder for soft rock and coal blasting.

He said the three men were the only persons in the 20 by 40 foot structure at the time. Other buildings escaped damage but operations were halted pending an investigation.

Court Clears Farben Chiefs Of War Plotting

NUERNBERG.—(AP)—A U. S. Military Tribunal Thursday acquitted all 24 directors of the giant I. G. Farben chemical combine of plotting and waging aggressive war, but convicted nine of them of looting in countries overrun by Hitler's Nazis.

The sprawling Farben plant at Ludwigshafen, death trap for probably 300 or more Germans in Thursday's mammoth explosion, lay in smoldering ruins as the court decided the fate of the men who directed Farben, the symbol of Nazi Germany's industrial might.

Price of Fags Jumps a Cent

NEW YORK.—(AP)—Leading cigarette manufacturers Thursday announced wholesale price increases which are expected to cost the smoker about one cent more a package.
