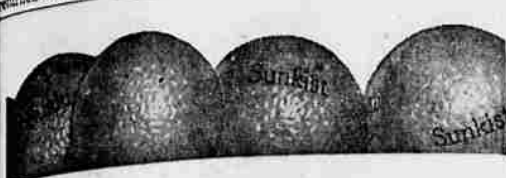


Thanks, But No Thanks

FCC Runs Nation's Radios From the Cradle to the Grave

WASHINGTON—(AP)—Radio is spreading so widely it's reaching out to cover people from the cradle to the grave.

A diaper service in the South-west wants a license for a two-way radio-exchange between its office and its trucks.

And a cemetery near Chicago is so busy it wants an okay to use radio in directing traffic.

In both cases the Federal Communications commission has been asked for approval.

Those two extreme cases show pretty well how radio has blossomed to cover all kinds of living and activity.

This will give an idea of the spread:

Popularity Spreads
In the war years 912 regular commercial radio broadcasting stations were operating in this country.

They were the familiar, standard AM—amplitude modulation—radio stations.

And during the war there were only 48 FM—frequency modulation—stations running. FM, among other things, cuts static down or out.

The war froze all kinds of new radio building. But the boom got under way when the shooting stopped.

Now there are about 2000 regular AM stations. The FCC has applications to let 600 more set up shop.

FMs Authorized
And the FCC has okayed 1000

except in the case of one who is filling an unexpired term — is seven years. The salary is \$10,000.

The FCC doesn't charge any fee for its license. But it investigates the application of anyone wanting to open a station.

The air waves are policed by the FCC which has 14,000 employees and 22 stations, scattered around the country, to monitor all types of radio broadcasting.

But —

1. There are 75,000 amateurs by the FCC to broadcast.

2. And there are 55,000 other types of radio stations operating, all licensed by FCC. They include police, fire, forest ranger, railroad, airline and taxicab broadcasting stations, and so on.

The FCC has to license all broadcasting of any kind because only a limited number of broadcasts can be on the air at any one time without interfering with one another.

Before any station can be on the air, it must have a license from the FCC. The law requires that.

The law passed, and the FCC created, in 1934. The FCC is made up of seven commissioners appointed by the president. Not more than four can be members of the same political party.

Each commissioner's term —

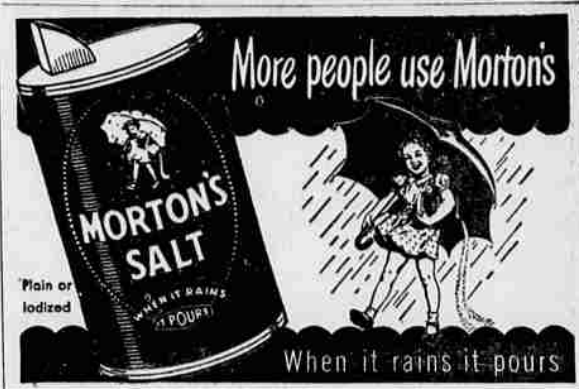

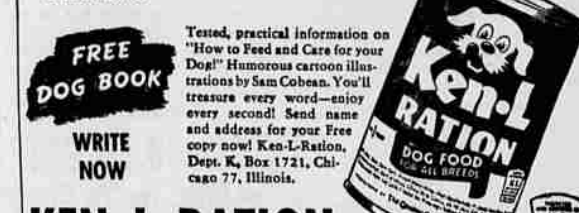
