



Purse Claimed in 23 Seconds

Cheyenne, Wyo. — (AP) — Col. Lee, fast roping Fort Sumner, N.M., rode ace, pocketed \$912 Thursday for about 23 seconds work at Cheyenne's 52nd Frontier Days.

Lee won first go around money Wednesday in the steer roping event with a low time of 22.7 seconds, set on the first day of the event.

Second place money went to Ed Bennett, Falcon, Colo., cowboy, who drew down \$684, for a time of 23.8 seconds. Everett Shaw of Stoneham, Okla., took \$456 for third best time of 24.5 seconds.

Lee won the 1948 Frontier Days championship steer roping, while Bennett won the title in 1938.

A second day crowd of nearly 20,000 spectators saw Jim Boyle of Hensley, Neb., walk off with \$912 for a time of 10 seconds flat in the first go around of the bull-roping contest.

His time was one of the best ever recorded for the event at Cheyenne in many years. Homer Polgrew of Chandler, Ariz., won \$456 for 18.4 seconds work, and Dave Campbell, Las Vegas, Nev., won for 10.8.

Wednesday's calf roping event produced slower times than those posted on Tuesday. Zeno Farris of Las Cruces, N.M., was top man with a time of 14.5 seconds.

Ed Whitley of Hugo, Okla., placed in the best ride aboard a bucking horse, followed closely by the Brown of Denver.

Tom Knight of Cody, Wyo., and veteran bronc buster Ned Ferraro of Las Vegas, N.M., finished one-two in the professional bronc riding event.

Union Plans Joint Services

PRINCETON, Ind. — (AP) — The local union of the United Mine Workers Thursday planned a joint memorial service for the 100 miners who died in an explosion at the King's Mine Tuesday.

Survivors of the miners planned separate funeral services for the dead Thursday.

Meanwhile, a crew of investigators still roamed the area of the "safe" tunnel in which the blast occurred. State and federal inspectors issued a preliminary report Wednesday, blaming accumulated gas for the disaster.

But State Mine Inspector Griffith Morris said he would investigate further. The tunnel was in part of the mine that had not been worked for two months before the blast, and investigators and a committee from the UMW had declared the area "safe" only last Sunday.

The wife and children of Elzie Malone, 61, one of the blast victims, cancelled a trip to California. Malone would have retired next week.
