Ice Pack Halts Rescue Convoy

POINT BARROW, Alaska—(AP)—An eight ship Navy convoy's race to bring a year's supplies to the top of the North American continent was blocked Tuesday, at least temporarily, by the grinding Arctic ice pack.

Dependent on the 42,000 tons of cargo carried by the fleet are the Navy's oil exploration bases and native village on the upper rim of Alaska.

The narrow Arctic sea channel was sealed by north winds Monday, less than two weeks after the latest breakup since 1938.

Menace of the ice stalled the flotilla at Point Lay, a day's voyage to the Southwest.

Eight Ships
 The eight ships, including five 14,000-ton attack transports, are manned by 2500 Navy men. They carry lumber, fuel, vehicles and other equipment vital to continuation of the Navy's hunt for oil at the "top of the world."

The Coast Guard Cutter Northwind, sent here in advance of the convoy, raced for open water Sunday as the shifting winds drove the ice toward shore.

A party for 20 orphan Eskimo children aboard the Northwind had to be interrupted so the ice-breaker could hurry at full speed toward safety.

Walrus Stranded
 Navy aerial observers said Tuesday the pack was closed so tightly that walrus herds were forced to waddle miles across the ice to find patches of water.

In Juneau, a federal official said that Eskimos in the Point Barrow and Wainwright areas face a desperate food situation.

Charles Gillham, U. S. Fish and Wildlife Service biologist, reported on his return there from an Arctic survey, that natives of the two villages have been unable to kill a single whale or walrus this summer due to unusual ice conditions.

Polar Claims Still Plague

BUENOS AIRES, Argentina—(AP)—Diplomatic circles reported Tuesday that the United States has proposed an eight-nation trusteeship for the Antarctic to settle conflicting claims on south polar territory.

Argentina and Chile, chief South American claimants, reportedly ejected the idea. Chilean officials were said to have taken the stand that Chile would reassert her claims as soon as the international situation has been "stabilized."

Argentina continued to call for an international conference on the issue.

The proposal was reportedly circulated by Edward Green of the U. S. State Department during a recent visit to the two South American countries.

Green was said to have suggested a joint administration of the region by the United States, Britain, Argentina, Chile, Norway, Finland, Australia and New Zealand. Each of the nations claim a sector of the Antarctic and several of the sectors overlap.

Green reportedly presented his proposal to former Chilean Foreign Minister German Vergara Donoso and Diplomatic Department Director Enrique Bernstein before coming here to confer with Argentine Foreign Undersecretary Enrique la Rosa.
