

# Presbyterian Church Reports Gains in Membership, Finances

Statistics in membership and finances recorded by the Presbyterian Church in the U. S. A. for the nine-month period from 1 to Dec. 31, 1947, according to statistics just released from the office of the general assembly in Philadelphia, Pa.

Statistics were compiled on the basis of the change in membership for the fiscal year, which commenced Jan. 1, 1948. Henceforth church year will be from Jan. 1 to Dec. 31, instead of from 1 to March 31.

Membership figures for the month period showed a net gain of 39,446. The number of new members added to the church rolls was 76,144, bringing the total membership to 2,274,482, the largest in the history of organized Presbyterianism in America.

Standing spiritual progress manifested in the rapid development of the New Life Movement, the new curriculum in the church schools, the formation of the new National Council of Presbyterian laymen, and the near completion of the church's \$27,000,000 Restoration Fund.

**Religion Flourishes**

The Presbyterian Church in the U. S. A. has churches in every state in the union. Flourishing missions have been developed in Alaska, the Pacific Islands, China, Japan, India, and Africa. Since the organization of the first pres-

bytery in Philadelphia in 1706, the church has grown steadily, and has served as a strong and loyal defender of civil and religious liberty, and political democracy, in America.

Nationally, the church is organized in 40 synods and 267 presbyteries. There are 8,534 local churches and 9517 ministers. Eighty of the ministers are still serving as chaplains in the armed forces. Young men now under care of the church as candidates for the ministry number 1446.

Of the total contributions of the local churches, \$80,043,682 was used throughout the nine months for local and denominational expenses. The benevolence budget causes of the church received \$7,119,086 from living givers. This sum has been distributed among the benevolence agencies as follows:

**Board of National Missions** (maintaining work throughout the United States and their territorial possessions), \$3,022,387.

**Board of Foreign Missions** (maintaining missions in 16 foreign countries), \$2,617,538.

**Board of Christian Education** (promoting educational work in churches, schools, colleges and theological seminaries), \$919,031.

**Board of Pensions** (administering relief and pension to ministers, missionaries and their dependents), \$351,685.

**Theological Seminaries**, 147,850.

**American Bible Society**, \$43,701.

**Federal Council of Churches**, \$16,894.
