Wage Rate Increase Proposal for Springfield Consideration

 SPRINGFIELD — A proposed amendment to increase the sewer rates from \$5 per year to \$1 per month will be the principal item at Monday's regular meeting of the city council.
 At an adjourned meeting last Friday, the council ordered the attorney to draw up the amendment for the rate increase to be presented at Monday's meeting for the first reading.
 All discussion regarding the increases will take place at Monday meeting. Opinion, comment, suggestions, or criticism from Springfield citizens during this amendment will be heard.
 The rate increase has been recommended by the council to raise revenue to retire the \$100,000 bond issue which will be used for the construction of a sewage disposal plant. Voters will vote on the bond issue in 1941, but no work was started.
 Because of the war, shortage of materials prevented construction of the plant. However, at the last meeting the council instructed the manager to look into possibilities for the plant, and to estimate the feasibility of going ahead with construction.
 The State Sanitary Authority, a division of the State Department of Health, has been active in campaigning for the reduction of stream pollution. It has after all cities that use river water for disposal of raw sewage.
 The city is planning to construct sewage plants as soon as materials and finances warrant.

The meeting will begin at 7:30 p. m. in the city hall.

Bean Pickers Need Reported

Fifty more bean pickers will be needed Monday morning to help meet the harvest demands of clamoring bean growers. Pay is running at two and a half cents a pound with a quarter cent bonus on completion of the harvest.
