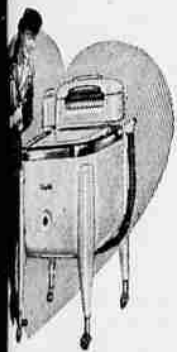


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Obsidians Go Off to Camp

Autopsy Report Still Awaited

Lane County Deputy Coroner Fred Buell was still waiting Saturday for the autopsy report on the death of Arthur E. Wyble, 37, Harrisburg, who died in a convulsion in a Eugene hospital Monday night.

Authorities from Linn County, investigating the death, are waiting for the report to clear their records in the case.

Wyble was seized by convulsions in his home Monday evening without warning. He was rushed to the hospital but efforts to save him failed.

Laundry Employees Ponder Organizing

A move to seek organized union contracts with laundries and dry cleaning establishments in Lane County was underway Saturday, with a formal meeting of workers scheduled Monday night.

The meeting has been called to elect officers for local union 206, AF of L, which secured a charter in 1941 but which failed to obtain contracts in this area.

Union leaders at Carpenters' Hall, who are calling the meeting, said they believed minimum laundry workers' wages were about 50 cents, and the maximum about 65 cents. The first action on the part of the new union will be to seek contracts authorizing higher pay, the leaders said.

The organizational meeting will be in Hall A of Carpenters' Hall, 507 Willamette St., at 8 p.m. Monday, Aug. 9.
