Psycho Hospital Planned For Fort Funston Site

SAN FRANCISCO (U.P.)—Preliminary plans have been drafted for a thousand-bed hospital here for neuro-psychiatric veterans, it was announced Thursday by the Veterans Administration.

Cost of the building has been estimated at between \$18,000,000 and \$20,000,000. It will be located on 200 acres now occupied by the Army's Fort Funston.

The Veterans Administration acquired the land without cost after it recently was declared "excess."

Japanese Labor Policy Explained

TOKYO (U.P.)—Japan's two million government and public service employees learned Thursday exactly what the new McArthur-inspired government labor policy means.

A four-point note has been issued to all government workers' unions. It provides that:

1. The right of collective bargaining will not be recognized henceforth, but employees may submit their grievances, opinions and requests to senior officials.
2. Labor contracts and under-

standings existing hitherto have been invalidated and management councils automatically disbanded. Existing wages and working conditions will be continued unless they contradict the provisions of the cabinet edict.

3. Employees who work exclus-

tively for their union will not be recognized.

4. No strike, sabotage, or other actions obstructing normal administrative business shall be permitted.

Those affected by the directive are workers in government mono-

polies such as railway system, telephone, telegraph, wireless and "ministerial" government workers.

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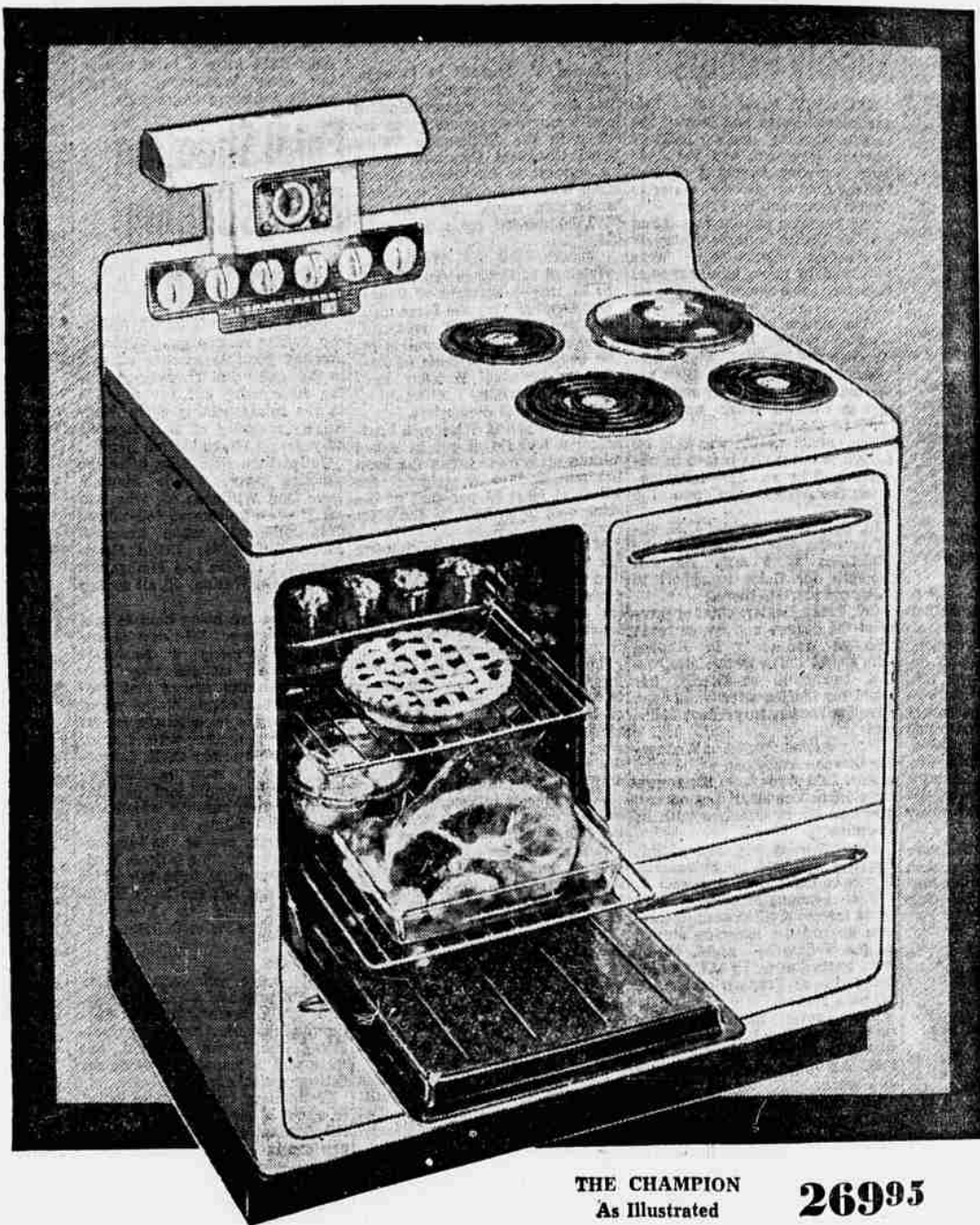
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
