Colored movies on highlights of the University of Oregon during the past year were shown the Eugene Active Club Thursday noon by Les Anderson, alumni director on the campus and producer of the promotional movie.

Made possible by contributions from the Oregon Federation, a Eugene group of men interested in student promotion, the \$1000 film will be shown to 11,000 high school students throughout the state next year.

Anderson stressed the fact that "good, well-rounded students" are sought for the University of Oregon and that "volume then takes care of itself."

In addition to student life and various schools at work, the film covers exciting moments from the Oregon - Oregon State College game of last year.

The Active Club will join six other civic-spirited local organizations in a picnic Aug. 29 at Roseburg, has a donkey baseball game slated for next week, and the Hawaiian All-Stars baseball club scheduled for Sept. 1 in Eugene.

Molotov Sees Three Envoys

MOSCOW — (AP) — The envoys of the United States, Britain and France conferred with Soviet Foreign Minister Molotov for almost three hours Thursday.

U.S. Ambassador Walter B. Smith, French Ambassador Yves Chataigneau and the special British envoy, Frank Roberts, motored together from the American Embassy to the Kremlin for the appointment with Molotov at 5 p.m. (7 a.m. PST).

It was the fourth time in two weeks the western representatives have called upon Molotov for talks aimed at ending Soviet blockade of Berlin and a solution of other East-West difference in Europe.

(A diplomatic informant in London said Thursday that the West "can be expected to ask" Prime Minister Stalin to intervene personally in the Berlin stalemate if the talks with Molotov fail. The informant, who has been following the Moscow exchanges from the inside, said that up until Wednesday there had been no softening in the western powers' line.)

Smith told correspondents that the three westerners would confer at the U.S. Embassy after the Kremlin meeting.

"I'll give you my usual no comment statement," he said.

Lots of River Bottom Foreclosed for Taxes
BEATRICE, Neb. — (AP) — One is likely to find almost anything in the crop of tax foreclosure suits which have been going through the district court here.

Last year, the town of Liberty was surprised when its town hall wound up on the foreclosure list. The most recent discoveries include eight lots in the bottom of the Blue River. Four others barely miss being there; portions of them are on a tiny island in the river.

Taxes on the lots have not been paid since the 1880s.

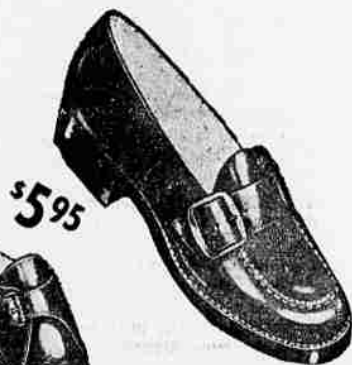
