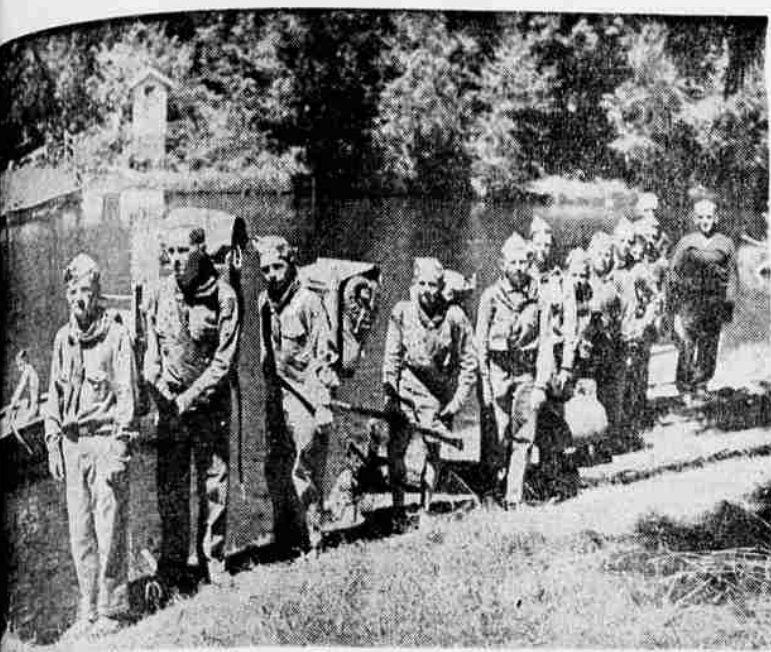

New Church Well Started

PLASTERING was under way Saturday on the new Methodist Church which the congregation hopes to occupy Jan. 1.

The first funds for the new church were raised in 1943, but construction was not started until this year when assets in the building reached a total of \$30,000.

Directors of the project, church members, were inspired by the late Rev. Bruce Baxter and has been led by Rev. Frank E. Brown, pastor of the church.

Equipment is being installed throughout the new building, including oil heat, air conditioning, light-weight exploded volcanic glass plexer, ramp approaches to the educational unit, rock lath and recessed nave lighting.

Structure

The edifice is of Gothic architecture and red rug brick and will be adorned with cathedral windows. The frame work consists of laminated arches set inside of cloistered aisles.

A campaign for additional funds is under the direction of John Henry Soltman, field representative of the Methodist Board of Church Extension of Philadelphia. The building fund campaign was launched Aug. 11 and will continue through the month.

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County Fair: Preliminary Work Gets Underway for Annual Event

Activity was picking up at the Lane County fairgrounds this weekend as commercial exhibitors and farm families began planning their exhibits for the annual county fair.

Commercial booth space was almost exhausted Saturday, even though the fair won't open until Sept. 22. Grange women have already signed up for seven food concessions, and men, women and children devoted to agricultural and home activities are beginning to think about the products they will show.

Thirty Assigned

Thirty Granges were assigned space in the main exhibit building during a meeting of Grange managers this week. Those that signed for food concessions are Dorena, Spencer Creek, Irving, Franklin, Jasper, Lowell and Goshen.

While it lasts, commercial booth space for the four-day event may be secured by calling Ernest McCulloch, secretary-manager of the county fair board.

Deadline

The fairgrounds will be open for the reception of exhibits two days before the formal opening of the fair. All entries must be made, and all exhibits must be in place before 9 a. m. on the first day of the fair.

Livestock entries, however, will close Saturday, Sept. 18, at 8 p. m. Division chairmen for the livestock exhibits will be: Mrs. C. A. Huntington, chairman of the horse exhibits; Chester Chase and R. M. Lyon, cattle division; F. D. Petzold and John Hill, sheep and goats; Earl Drury, swine; Noble Wheeler, poultry department.

Leaders

O. N. Mickelson will be superintendent of the industrial arts department, and O. S. Fletcher will head the land products division.

Oak Hill Kids School Picked

Following inspection of facilities at Stella Maglady school Friday, parents of school children living in the Oak Hill district agreed that the youngsters should be transported to the Maglady unit for classes during the coming school year.

Approximately 35 or 40 children will be added to Maglady's enrollment through this arrangement. Oak Hill district consolidated with the Eugene system at an election June 1.

The city school superintendent's office reported Saturday that the District 4 projected building program includes construction of an elementary school on a new location in the Oak Hill district.

Assistant Superintendent Dean Lobaugh noted that Maglady will be unable to handle all of the Oak Hill youngsters longer than a year. Accordingly, he said, a primary school may be constructed in the suburban area in another year.

The new building would be planned for later expansion into a full-fledged, six-class grade school.

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
