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## Springfield Gets 3 School Buses

SPRINGFIELD — With three buses added to the eight used last year, School Superintendent E. H. Silke hopes to meet the requirements of an additional 300 pupils in Springfield schools.

One bus will be placed on a Goshen run, the second on Upper Camp Creek, and the third will draw local schedules.

Present estimates indicate that 1500 students will be riding the buses daily. Last year's total was 1200. More than 69,339 miles were traveled during the school year with a total of 1,331,782.5 pupil miles.

Cost of the program was \$20,470.12 discounting the Thurston bus which only touched Springfield files late in the year. Based on a pupil mile cost of .016 cents, a major portion of the expense will be replaced in district funds by a state allowance of one cent per pupil mile.

In the cost figures are pay for drives, fuel, maintenance, and depreciation estimates. The system is short two drivers now, but Silke expects to have qualified men on the job with the opening of the school year.

## Woman Starts Globe Circuit

CAMBRIDGE, England — (AP) — Mrs. Richarda Morrow Tait, beautiful artist's model and mother, took off Wednesday in an attempt to become the first woman to circle the globe in a light plane.

"I am full of confidence," she said. "I am taking my lucky penny with me."

She was accompanied by Michael Townsend, 25, a Cambridge University student and bachelor who will serve as navigator.

Mrs. Morrow Tait's husband and 18-months-old daughter Anna waved goodbye as the single-engine Percival Proctor plane

climbed into the sky for the first because Mrs. Morrow Tait was leg of the six-weeks flights.

It will make two stops in England before traveling east via France, Italy, the Middle East, Burma, China, the Aleutian Islands, Alaska, Canada, Newfoundland and Greenland.

Mrs. Morrow Tait and Townsend will pay most of the expenses for the flight. The plane, a former Royal Air Force trainer, was named "Thursday's Child."

Townsend said he took a rifle along because "We fly over Alaska and other uninhabited territory."

Mrs. Morrow Tait said she "felt awfully bad about leaving my baby and worse about leaving my husband."

"But," she added, "I have a lot to come back to."

## Last Bodies Found in C-47

CUENO, Italy — (AP) — The last five bodies of the 20 Americans who were killed last November in the crash of a U. S. Army C-47 transport on Mount Carabonnet were removed from the wreckage of the plane Wednesday.

A mass funeral service will be held Saturday, attended by high American Air Force officials and Italian military men. An Italian guard of honor is watching over the bodies meanwhile.

Most of the bodies still have not been identified definitely, and authorities were withholding identifications pending notification of next of kin.

It was established that two men survived the first impact of the crash but died later. One of them had suffered a broken leg, and it was bound with a torn necktie and had been treated with medicine from a first aid kit. Another man had donned many layers of clothing apparently in a futile attempt to avoid freezing to death.
