Public Domain Timber Sale Set

The Bureau of Land Management will open bids in Portland Sept. 14 for the sale of over 64 million feet of public domain timber in nine western Oregon counties.

W. H. Horning, regional land management bureau chief, said the timber is valued at \$876,850. The bulk of the timber is located on Oregon-California land agency and Coos Bay Wagon Road lands in Coos, Douglas, Jackson, Klamath, Lane and Polk Counties.

Lane Timber

Lane County timber up for sale is as follows:

Upper Willamette Marketing area, about five miles northwest of Mable in the Mohawk area, estimated to contain 5,615,000 board feet Douglas Fir, 15,000 hemlock, 100,000 red cedar, 30,000 incense cedar, 7750 lineal feet red cedar poles. No bid for less than \$12.80 per thousand board feet for the Douglas Fir, \$5.25 for the hemlock, \$4.85 for red cedar and incense cedar, five cents per lineal foot for the red cedar poles, or a total purchase price of \$72,968.75 will be considered. The sale area consists of about 105.62 acres.

Sluslaw Marketing area, about seven miles north of Blachly, contains estimated 3,560,000 board feet Douglas Fir, 10,000 feet hemlock. No bid for less than \$12.85 per thousand for the Douglas Fir, \$4.05 for the hemlock, or a total purchase price of \$45,786.50, will be considered. The sale area consists of about 49.65 acres.

Upper Willamette Marketing Area, on Hills Creek, contains an estimated 1,180,000 feet Douglas Fir, 10,000 feet hemlock, 45,000 feet western red cedar. Appraised prices are \$17.15 for the Douglas Fir, \$5.20 for the hemlock, \$4.80 for the western red cedar; the total appraised price is \$20,505. The sale area consists of approximately 9.07 acres in lot 12 and 22.04 acres in lot 11.

Anthropologist Joins Staff at University

Dr. Theodore Stern, an authority on North American Indian pottery and an anthropologist of the University of Pennsylvania, has been named an assistant professor of anthropology in the University of Oregon.

In addition to his studies of Indian pottery, he has conducted archaeological work in Maine, and contributed articles to the archaeological journal, "American Antiquity."

Both his master's and doctor's degrees were conferred by Pennsylvania, in 1941 and 1948.

Oregon, New York Stamps Go on Sale

Two new commemorative stamps will go on sale Monday at the postoffice. These are the Oregon Centennial three-cent stamp and the New York five-cent air-mail stamp which commemorates the 100th anniversary of the consolidation of the five boroughs into New York City.

Supplies of both are somewhat limited, according to Postmaster Ethan Newman. About 5000 of each have been received.

Ex-Education Dean Takes Texas Post

J. R. Jewell, former dean of the University of Oregon school of education, will leave next week to take a position with Trinity University at San Antonio, Tex.

He will do part-time teaching in psychology, assist the university's president in reorganization of the student counseling system, and act as educational advisor for the 2500 resident liberal arts students there.

Mr. and Mrs. Jewell will stay in San Antonio for the winter, but expect to return to Eugene next June.

Condemnation Suit on File

A condemnation suit was on file Saturday on behalf of Springfield Union High School against A. J. Perkins and Sadie Perkins, owners of 5.5 acres of land the high school district needs for the ultimate expansion of its plant.

The district boundary board instructed the district attorney to bring suit when the school board filed a resolution stating that it was not possible to arrive at a negotiated sale.

The complaint lists an offer of \$2232 for the land, based on an appraisal by three impartial appraisers. The boundary board was told the owners refused to sell for less than \$20,000.

William S. Fort, attorney for the school district, said that Perkins bought the land from the county before the war for \$37.50 an acre, or about \$207.

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Architecture Faculty At UO Adds to Staff

Appointment of Robert R. Ferens as assistant professor of architecture in the University of Oregon has been announced by Dean S. W. Little.

Ferens, a resident of Newton, Mass., was graduated from Pratt Institute, Brooklyn, N. Y., and completed graduate work at Massachusetts Institute of Technology.

During the war, Ferens was connected with the Sperry Gyroscope Co., and later was in charge of the first installation of the system in the Consolidated Vultee XB-32

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super-bomber. Following the war he joined a New York architectural firm, and later was a draftsman for various architectural and engineering firms in Boston.

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Sept. 27 Set For Opening

SPRINGFIELD — With the closing this week of the Willamalane Park and Recreation District summer session, Superintendent Irene Squires announced the winter session will get underway Sept. 27.

Until that time only events will be touch football games at Bratton Field Tuesday and Thursday evenings at 7 p. m.

In the summer season ending Friday more than 52,000 adults, teen-agers, and children used the facilities and took part in the supervised recreational programs of the district, according to a post season report released Saturday.

This figure more than doubled the 1947 total of 16,175.

Leaburg, Deerhorn Vote On Consolidation Due

Voters in the Leaburg and Deerhorn elementary school districts will ballot Tuesday, Aug. 24, on a proposal to merge the Deerhorn school with Leaburg.

The issue was originally scheduled for voting Aug. 12 but election notices were not posted and thus required a new date.

The Deerhorn school district has been rated conditionally standard by the state department of education — a status which requires several improvements of facilities to become standard.

Polling places will be open in each district from 8 to 9 p. m.

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
