NEW YORK — (AP) — There will be a 1948-49 Metropolitan Opera season after all.

Officers of the Metropolitan Opera Ass'n. announced the new decision after the employees' unions shelved demands for wage increases and other benefits.

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University Expecting to Move Into New Warehouse by Sept. 15

The University of Oregon expects to move its maintenance and storage functions into a new, \$235,000 warehouse by Sept. 15, but will continue to work on the building until early November, when it is scheduled for completion.

H. D. Jacoby, assistant superintendent of the university's physical plant and man in charge of the construction, said Wednesday that the new building will be nearly twice as large as the one that burned down Feb. 11, 1947.

Classroom Space
 Since the fire, the university's maintenance work and storage have been accommodated in temporary buildings which must be evacuated by Sept. 15 so they can be used for classrooms.

Construction of the new, 100 by 200-foot warehouse and shops was delayed earlier this year when

high water saturated the fill material.

A 24,000 square foot concrete floor will be poured next Wednesday, Jacoby said. Other construction is scheduled to continue while the various plant operations are moving into the building.

To Four Floor
 An estimated \$75,000 worth of supplies for various university branches will be stored in space not used for maintenance and repair shops. Vehicles will be stored in the new building only temporarily, while a new area is being prepared, Jacoby said.

One of the principal features of the new shops and warehouse will be the year-round operation of a complete cabinet shop. It is estimated that by building its own special-order laboratory and classroom equipment, a considerable saving can be made by the university.

Willamalane Project Endorsed by B P W

SPRINGFIELD — Endorsement of the Willamalane Park bond issue which goes to voters Tuesday, Aug. 31, was given Wednesday by the Springfield Business and Professional Women's Club.

Mrs. Ersel Zimmerman, chairman of the BPW public affairs committee, said the Willamalane program is "one of the major projects for the coming year."

In expressing the opinion of the club, Mrs. Al Knapp, president, said "The response to the swimming program for this past summer has proved that Springfield is desperately in need of such facilities of its own."

She said it was the duty of all

registered voters in the park and recreation district to see that their children have such play facilities. The bond issue is to raise \$285,000 to finance a swimming pool and wading pool, recreation building and various other facilities. All legal voters may vote on the proposal since state law does not restrict the voice to taxpayers or freeholders.

DEATH SAID NATURAL

The Lane County coroner's office received information Wednesday that the death of Arthur W. Wible of Harrisburg Aug. 2 was due to natural causes. The man died in a convulsion shortly after being brought to a Eugene hospital on that date. The state crime detection laboratory in Portland has aided the local coroner in determining cause of death.

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
