

University Registration Tops 6000 for New Record

For the first time in 72 years, the University of Oregon has topped the 6000 enrollment figure. An estimate of total registration from the office of Clifford Constance, registrar, places the enrollment at 6040.

Continuing the post-war trend is the ratio of men to women students. While the number of co-

eds actually dropped by seven per cent, more than 300 more male students enrolled this year than for fall term 1947.

This increase is contrary to the general trend throughout the nation. A breakdown of the attendance and enrollment report for the period ending last Saturday indicated most of the increase comes from transfers. This is especially true of the junior and senior classes where increases of 43 and 23 per cent have been recorded. Of the 2132 new students, only 1497 are freshmen, indicating a transfer enrollment of 635.

Fewer freshmen and sophomores are registered this year than at this time a year ago. The freshman class shows a decline of four per cent; and 12 per cent fewer sophomores registered this year. An increase of 19 per cent is shown among graduate students.

The "big three" in terms of enrollment have retained their standings. The college of liberal arts enrolled 2642 students this year. The business administration school follows with 1456 and the school of architecture and allied arts is third with 747. Listed in order of enrollment figures are: law, 416; health and physical education, 241; music, 198; journalism, 138; education, 104; general studies, 6; auditors, 5.

Three schools with usually high enrollments have shown a drop over last year's figures. The law school shows a 5 per cent drop but this is partially accounted for by the strengthening of a mission requirements that now stipulate a student must spend three years in the liberal arts school before admission to law study. The schools of journalism and education were re-organized on an upper-division and graduate level this year. Students intending to major in either of these schools must spend their freshman and sophomore years in liberal arts.

Party Cancels House Nominees

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The Progressive Party said Friday it has withdrawn 13 of its candidates for the House because, among other things, the Democratic nominees "have now turned to a much more constructive liberal path."

The candidates withdrawn include those opposing Reps. Helen Gahagan Douglas and Chet Holifield in California.

C. B. Baldwin, chairman manager for Henry A. Wallace, Progressive Party presidential candidate, announced the action.

He also said the party has withdrawn its candidate for governor of Connecticut against Democrat Chester Bowles, former OPA director, but that it has not endorsed Bowles.

Baldwin said the fact that Bowles did not want Progressive Party support created a "difficult situation."

"But," he added, "we recognized that Bowles had been under great pressure and he yielded to expediency, so we withdrew our candidate, but have not endorsed Bowles."
