He said they aren't "opponents," but "enemies," and "their real intention is to surrender this country—its resources and its people—our earnings and our children—to a

chosen few who will march us either to slavery or to war—or to both." Mentioning the flood that wiped out the nearby Vanport housing project last spring, Wallace said: "I am certain that homeless Americans must be asking themselves how it is that their government moves so slowly and smoothly to build Arctic air bases, to dredge harbors for reactionary regiments in Europe, to relieve the plight of unfortunate Arab chiefs and African plantation owners, while Americans suffer in squalor, waiting and waiting for adequate housing."

Crime-Comics Huddle Between States Asked

BAKER, Ore. —(UPI)—A magazine wholesaler for seven western states Friday said local or state censorship would not solve the crime-comics problem.

Leo Adler who said his firm's western demand was 80 per cent comic books thought local censorship only confused the publishers as some states banned some comics and others praised the same.

He urged a huddle of publishers and wholesalers to set national standards.
