**School-Work Rules Outlined**  
 Most veterans attending school full-time under the G.I. Bill may work part-time and still draw full subsistence pay from the Veterans Administration, Kenneth L. Farner, VA representative for this area, pointed out Monday.  
 The only income limitation applies to the amount of subsistence paid within combined ceilings, Mr. Farner said. Actually, a veteran may earn as much as he wishes on outside jobs, though it may reduce his VA checks.  
 Ceilings for combined earning and subsistence are: \$210 monthly for veterans without dependents; \$270, with one dependent; \$290, with two or more dependents. These limits were fixed by the 80th Congress.  
 If a veteran's earned income plus subsistence allowance exceeds the monthly ceiling, the VA must reduce its payments to keep him within the limit, Farner explained.  
 Full subsistence amounts to \$75 a month to a single student, \$105 if he has one dependent, and \$120 to a veteran with two or more dependents.  
 When a veteran enrolls, he must certify as to his expected income, so the VA can determine his subsistence. Material changes in earnings should be reported to the VA, Mr. Farner added.

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**Actress Elissa Landi Reported 'Improved'**  
 KINGSTON, N. Y.—(U.P.)—Elissa Landi, 44, former stage and screen star, rallied sufficiently Monday to talk with members of her family, her physician said.  
 He said Miss Landi, critically ill at Kingston Hospital for the past week, recovered consciousness and was "greatly improved." Her condition Sunday had been reported "poor" and a hospital attache said she slipped into a coma "no wand then."  
 Miss Landi was taken to the hospital when she suffered "a flareup of a chronic condition."  
 The Italian-born actress, who also won fame as a novelist, retired from the screen in 1943 when she married Curtiss Kinney Thomas, her second husband. They have lived on a farm near here ever since.

 Armida vehemently protested the judge's ruling. She said her husband's drinking makes him a bad influence upon the dog, a maltese terrier.

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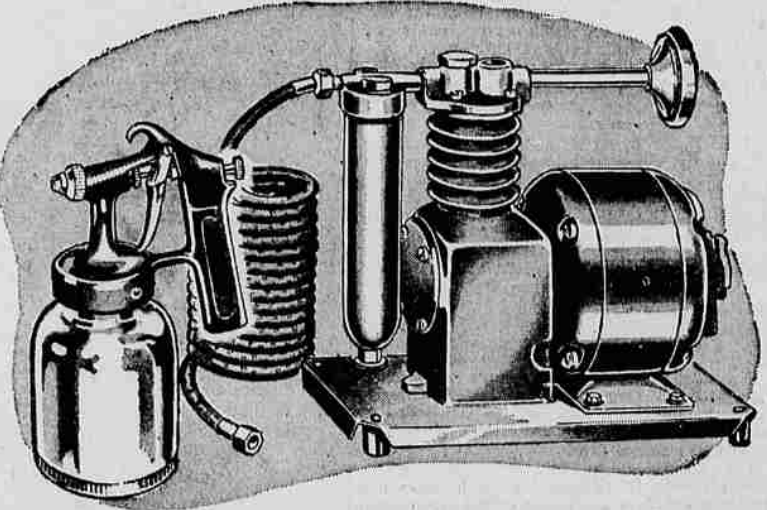
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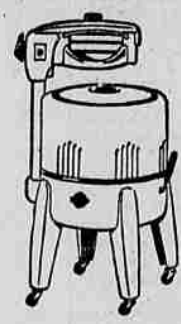


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
