Police Care for
Three Babies

PORTLAND — (U.P.) — Police had
care of three babies Wednesday
after finding them unattended in
automobiles.
Two were taken from a locked
automobile. Police, summoned by
passersby who were attracted by
their cries, broke a window to
reach them. The babies were both
under 6 months old. The mothers
were sentenced to 30 days in jail
for disorderly conduct, but muni-
cipal judge J. J. Quillin paroled
them to the women's protective
division provided they take child
care lessons from the Red Cross.
The other child, two months
old, was found alone in a car out-
side a tavern. A note was left
telling the parents to call at the
police station for their baby.
When they arrived an hour later,
police told them to come back
today and talk to the judge. The
Women's Protective Division kept
the baby overnight.

Break Seen
For Housewives

CHICAGO — (U.P.) — House-
wives will soon be able to buy
larger quantities and a greater
variety of food for less money, a
grocery executive said Thursday.
Paul S. Willis, president of
Grocery Manufacturers of Amer-
ica, Inc., said gradual declines in
food prices and a continuation of
high incomes should result in a
rosier future for the housewife.
Well in Line
"It seems probable that the
people will soon discover that
weekly grocery bills are well in
line with family income and
therefore can be expected to
maintain their interest in the eat-
ing of good food," he said.
Willis said that the national de-
fense program, the farm price
support program and the Euro-
pean recovery program all will
tend to keep the nation's general
economy on a high level, how-
ever.

"We will produce ample
quantities of food in the next
twelve months and there is evi-
dence that the American people
will have plenty of money with
which to buy them," he said.
Small Profit
He added that the grocery in-
dustry operates on the smallest
profit margin of any industry in
the nation, and said the grocers
have been trying to be as efficient
as possible in order to mark down
prices wherever they can.

He compared prices of specific
food items in Aug. 1947 and Sept.
1948, and said that many foods
have remained stable in price or
even have dropped.
Baby foods, canned wax beans,
canned beets, chewing gum, car-
bonated beverages, many cold
cereals, and canned corn were
among the items Willis said have
remained the same in price or in-
creased only 1/4 cent a package.
Lower Prices
Prices on canned apricots, dried
beans, grape juice, jams, jellies,
preserves, canned orange juice,
dried raisins, sugar, sardines,
prune juice and other items have
dropped, he said.
Willis and grocery executives
from all over the nation were in
Chicago for the 15th annual meet-
ing of the National Assn. of Food
Chains.

**Saw Bursts;

MELROSE, Mass. — (U.P.) — A five-
foot circular saw, rigged to the
rear wheels of a jacked automob-
ile, burst this week with the fol-

A piece of the saw went through
the roof of a schoolhouse a half
mile away.
A 15-pound chunk of the fly-
wheel flew over a crowded busi-
ness section and ripped into a
house a quarter of a mile away.
A piece of metal spun 300 feet
through the windshield of a new
car and dented the roof.
Another piece of the saw
crashed through the window of a
tenement house and showered two
occupants with glass and splinters.
Neither was injured.
The operator of the saw suf-
fered only a minor cut when the
belt snapped.
