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Vote Again, Junction City

JUNCTION CITY—The election may be over for Tom Dewey and Harry Truman but the voters of School District No. 69 will go to the Junction City Grade School Monday, Nov. 8, 2-7 p.m. to decide whether or not the district shall issue bonds in the amount of \$250,000 for the new grade school building.

This is the same proposal that was carried by a vote of 186 to 60 early in August, but which was voided by legal action which contested the validity of an earlier election.

It also necessitated a re-election to confirm the attitude of the people and secure the consolidation of School Districts 10, 15, 17, 69, 77, and 108.

The consolidation vote was held on September 17 and carried by a vote of 199 to 74, and at a special hearing Oct. 13 the Boundary Board confirmed the boundaries of the districts aligned with Junction City.

As it now comes before the voter of the district, the proposal calls for authorization of \$250,000 in bonds to provide funds to construct, equip, and furnish a new grade school building which has been approved in design and estimates, and for which the district already has the site, located immediately west of the City Park and Ball Grounds and north of the Gilmore Addition to Junction City.

Qualified to vote on this issue are all those whose names were on the last tax assessment roll and who are qualified as voters in their precinct from the following school districts: Junction City, Lancaster, Franklin, Union, Swamp Goldson, Laurelhme, Harmony, Oak Grove, and Harpole.

The voters qualifications have not changed despite the passage of the constitutional amendment at the general election on November 2.

The existing qualifications will remain in force until the Governor of Oregon formally proclaims the amendment effective as passed.

Leslie Grant, grade school superintendent, points to the problems that the school district now faces with increased enrollment. Questioned as to a probable "schedule of events" if the issue is authorized, Superintendent Grant hoped that the new building could be ready for next fall.

The Row River community in conjunction with the Sunday School are getting their Christmas entertainment under way. The parts have been "handed out" and the choir will begin practice soon.

Recently organized was the Mothers Club in Distortion whose duties will be similar to a school service club. The school enrollment this year being at a high of 91 students. Elected to office for this school term were Mrs. Marie Hogate, president, and Mrs. Carol Sheets as secretary treasurer.
