Grange Convention Endorses Federal Price Support Protection

PORTLAND, Me., (AP)—The National Grange convention Friday endorsed a system of flexible government price supports aimed at preventing future surpluses and shortages of farm products.

It took this action after defeating a proposal to continue indefinitely the present wartime support program of 90 per cent of parity.

Working to end its 10 day session by nightfall, the grange declined to take a stand on the controversial issue of compulsory health insurance.

Income Taxes
It went on record, however, against a reduction in income taxes during the present period of "high employment and income."

The convention did not say what the range of flexible supports should be in terms of percentages of parity.

(Parity is defined by law as a price which would be fair equal to farmers and those who buy his products.)

The Aiken-Hope Act passed by the last Congress set up a system of flexible supports ranging from 60 to 90 per cent of parity for major products, and from zero to 90 for other products.

Minimum Limit
The supports would be at the minimum limit of this range when supplies were excessive and at the high limit when supplies were short.

The grange endorsed the 60 to 90 per cent range when the matter was before Congress last summer.

The convention softened a stand taken by its Agriculture Committee on use of government marketing controls to combat surpluses and low prices.

The committee suggested that the grange favor use of such controls only as a "last resort."

Approve Controls
The convention rejected the suggestion, thus leaving the

grange on record as approving such controls in case of "urgent need" and when approved by two thirds of the affected growers.

The proposal to keep the present inflexible support program was made by J. W. Fichter, master of the Ohio State Grange. It got only four votes from the 73 delegates.

Also rejected was a proposal that farm prices be allowed to seek their own level in the markets, and that farms be paid government subsidies to assure them an adequate income.

'Socialized Medicine'
While the grange did not record itself on compulsory health insurance, it reiterated a stand against "socialized medicine."

However, the organization did not give its definition of that term.

The convention's resolution said that persons protected under a "comprehensive" voluntary health program should be exempt from any compulsory plan enacted by Congress.
