Driving Permits Soon Invalid

With only three months remain-
 ing before all driver's licenses ob-
 tained before June 1, 1947, are in-
 valid, many Oregon drivers have
 failed to renew expired permits,
 the secretary of state's office re-
 ports.
 More than 18,000 drivers were
 cited by state police alone last
 year for failure to have a valid
 driver's or chauffeur's license.
 Drivers are urged to check their
 permits now for expiration date
 and immediately renew if they
 have become invalid.
 Old licenses have been expiring
 in blocks of 33,000 each month
 since the 1947 date, with the re-
 newal system scheduled for com-
 pletion May 31 this year. All new
 permits expire on the holder's
 birth date in odd or even years
 according to the year of birth.
 Many drivers are confused be-
 cause the renewal date printed on
 their old license was extended
 during the war. The serial number
 determines expiration: If the
 number is preceded by "5R", the
 license expires on schedule re-
 gardless of printed dates. For ex-
 ample, all those numbered from
 5R660,001 to 5R693,000 must be
 renewed in February. All lower
 5R numbers have already expired
 and should be replaced immedi-
 ately. No penalty is attached to
 late renewals.
 Licenses obtained since the re-
 newal program began bear a "5R"
 serial number and expire accord-
 ing to the date on the license. The
 confusion arising from the two
 types of licenses will be ended
 when the changeover is complete.
 Complete information and renew-
 al schedules may be obtained at
 any police or driver's examiner
 office.

Stock, Poultry Value Reaches Record High

PORTLAND — (AP) — Value of
 livestock and poultry on Oregon
 farms is at a record high of
 \$187,887,000.
 The Department of Agriculture
 reported the number of animals
 up 21 per cent from the previous
 high of January 1 a year ago. The
 figure was double the 1942 mark.
 The increase was in beef cattle,
 hogs, sheep and turkeys. Decreas-
 ing were dairy cows, horses and
 chickens. The gain in sheep was
 the first in eight years.

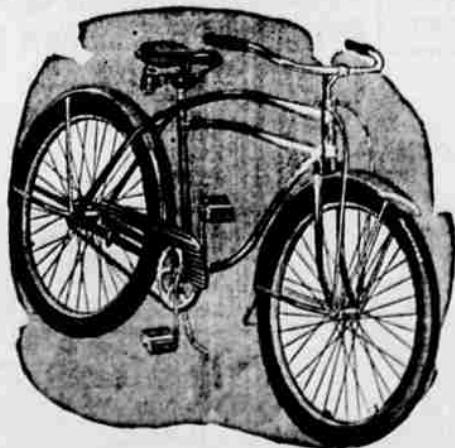

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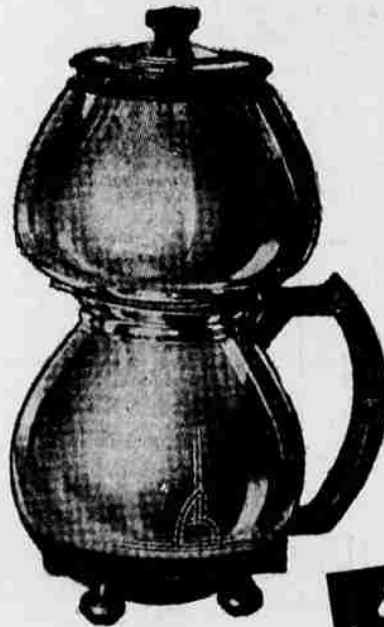
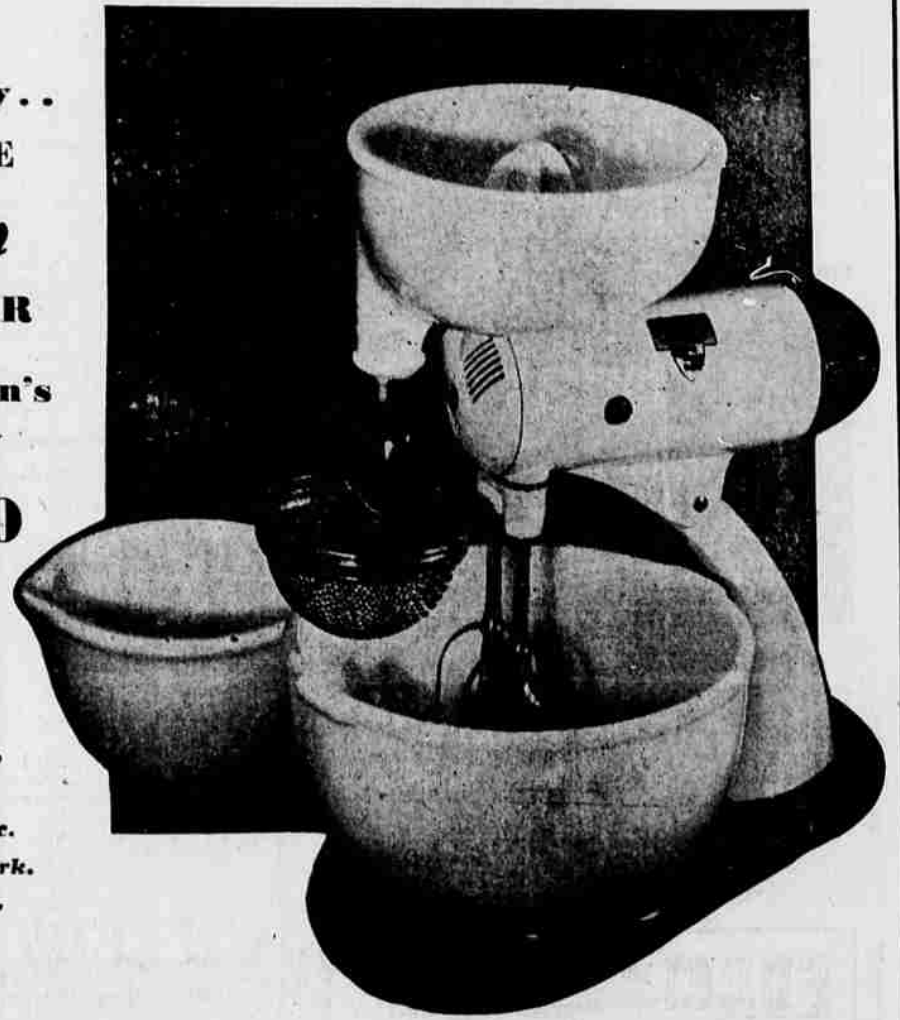
