

## Eugene Man Is Suicide

Bernal Van Bogart, 32, 731 Pearl St., Eugene, was found dead of a self-inflicted bullet wound in his car Sunday at 8 a. m. by Mr. and Mrs. John W. Lowe, Springfield, Coroner Phil Bartholomew reported.

The car was parked on Harlow Road, and Mr. and Mrs. Lowe became curious after they noticed the car on the way to the depot with friends, and saw that it was still there on their way home.

**Motive Unknown**  
Bartholomew said Bogart had shot himself with a pistol, and that the pistol was found in his hand. No motive was known.

Friends said the dead man had visited a tavern in Eugene and one in Springfield Saturday night. He then went to his apartment in Eugene about 2 a. m., and left at once. He was not seen again until his body was found.

**Relatives Notified**  
The coroner said relatives in Hawkeye, Iowa have been notified.

The body was taken to Bartholomew - Buell Mortuary pending instructions from relatives.

Bogart lived in Springfield before moving to Eugene, and at the time of his death was employed at a Eugene garage.

## German Sentenced For 'Match-Making'

DUESSELDORF, Germany — (AP)—A German court at Wuppertal sentenced Paul Friedrichs to serve eight months in jail Monday on a charge that he shared his wife with friends and fellow workers—for pay.

The prosecutor said "Friedrichs made extra money by inviting friends and fellow workers to his home and then offering them his wife," who was described as being between 30 and 40 years old. The specific charge against Friedrichs, a mechanic, was that he violated a German law barring "match-making."

## Bids Called on Sewer Line Construction

Bids have been called by the city for construction of several sanitary sewer lines, City Recorder Henry Biesel said Monday.

First of the projects is a six inch sewer on the west side of Olive St. between 23rd and 24th avenues, approximately 237 feet.

The other is for a sewer line, 12 inches in size, on the north side of First Avenue from Blair Blvd. to the west city limits, about 1475 feet in all.

Plans and specifications for the two jobs are available at the office of the city engineer in the city hall. Deadline for the bids is Monday, March 28 at 2 p. m.

## Vetch Deadline Extended for Filing

The deadline for filing applications for certification of Willamette vetch has been extended, County Extension Agent O. S. Fletcher announced Monday. His office will accept all applications up to and including March 28.

Fletcher said that the specialists from Oregon State College are scheduled to begin field inspections in the county on March 29. If possible, he would like to receive all applications by the end of this week to facilitate paper work.

Farmers applying are reminded to bring the blue tags from all bags in which they purchased their certified seed last fall. That is, seed which was used to plant the present crop of vetch.

They also are asked to have with them records of crops grown in 1946, 1947 and 1948 on the ground where the vetch to be inspected is now growing.

## Lane Dairymen Slate Annual Sessions

The annual meeting of the Lane County Dairy Herd Improvement Assn. is scheduled for Wednesday in the 4-H Club building on the county fairgrounds.

General business will be conducted in the morning session and the afternoon program is open to all dairymen whether or not they are members of the association. County Agent O. S. Fletcher said that the program should be of interest to all dairymen.

Officials of the group have announced that they have enough herds signed up to start another testing unit on April 1. There is room for several more herds in this unit and all interested farmers are asked to contact the county agent or one of the directors.

## IH Cuts Refrigerator Prices 8.3 Per Cent

CHICAGO — (AP)— Officials of the International Harvester Co., announced Monday price reductions averaging 8.3 per cent on 1949 household electric refrigerators.

Several other companies, including Sears Roebuck, have announced price cuts recently and International Harvester said the "competitive situation" forced the firm to reduce prices.

The Harvester officials said prices of home freezers would remain unchanged.

## Truman to Ask Military Fund

WASHINGTON — (AP)— President Truman is expected to ask Congress for a free hand in allocating arms to Western Europe under the proposed billion dollar military aid program.

The program is scheduled to go to the Capitol about the same time as the North Atlantic Security Treaty, or immediately thereafter. Mr. Truman will send up the treaty for Senate approval immediately after it is signed here by an expected 12 nations, two weeks from Monday.

According to present State Department — the department is rounding up all military aid programs for Mr. Truman—the President should try to get from Congress as much of a blank check authority as he can under whatever expenditure limit Congress fixes.

Present estimates are that more than \$1,000,000,000 will be required in the first 12 months to help Europe re-arm.
