

Refuse Disposal Is Progressing

County garbage disposal was reported progressing satisfactorily Tuesday with the problem at Oakridge under control and work proceeding at Creswell.

Following a tour of new disposal sites, the county garbage disposal committee reported that 11 sites have been procured or agreements have been made for their use in serving outlying communities.

Archie Shough, who is in charge

of the work, moved his equipment from Oakridge to Creswell this week.

Committee member Howard Buford reported that negotiations are in progress to secure a new site for the city of Eugene, but that the present dump will be continued for the time being.

Lane County voters last November approved a one and one-half mill levy to raise \$114,000 this year to launch the garbage disposal program. Once underway, the program is expected to require only a small maintenance budget. The county court administers the program.

Forest Value Bill Introduced

PENDLETON — (P) — Congressman Lowell Stockman has introduced a bill to pay annually 2 per cent of the fair value of national forest lands to the states for distribution to the counties in which the lands are located.

In speaking, Stockman said, "The national forest lands of the United States are generally estimated to be about \$800 million and they are lands on which no taxes are collected by the counties. While the federal government pays to the states for distribution to the counties, 25 per cent of all national forest receipts, there has been criticism of this plan, due to the inadequacy of the funds and also because the contributions are apt to be the least when prices are depressed and the need of the counties is the greatest."

The congressman further added: "I believe the bill I am introducing would establish a larger measure of both stability and equity of contribution to the counties. Each county would know at the beginning of each decade approximately the sum it would receive during the ensuing ten years from the then existing national forest lands. Long-term county budgets or financial programs thus could be formulated with a far greater degree of assurance than is possible under the present 25 per cent plan."

Rep. Stockman explained that he was particularly interested in this legislation since the percentages of area under forest service administration in the counties of the district he represents are as follows:

Baker 32.95; Crook 22.73; Deschutes 49.09; Grant 53.05; Harney 7.83; Hood River 61.74; Jefferson 13.97; Klamath 29.56; Lake 28.96; Malheur .06; Morrow 10.31; Umatilla 19.27; Union 45.94; Wallowa 56.00; Wasco 13.78; and Wheeler 15.11.

'Dust Bowl' Lands Available as Farms

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The House this week unanimously approved and sent to the Senate a bill to make thousands of acres of land in Montana, North Dakota and South Dakota available for farming.

The bill applies to 245,000 acres within the boundaries of Indian reservations, but not all of the land is suitable for farming. It was taken over by the Federal Government during the dry spells and dust storms of the 1930's.

Revenue derived from disposition of the land would be divided among the Indian tribes, the U.S. Treasury and the counties in which the land is located. The Indian tribes would get half the money, the Treasury and counties one-fourth each.

Cancer Check Find Made

LOS ANGELES — (AP) — Two scientists have announced discovery of a rapid and accurate method to check the effectiveness of cancer treatment.

Dr. P. M. West and Jessamine Hilliard of the University of California at Los Angeles, said that after a survey of 2300 cancer cases, the method has become standard procedure at Birmingham Veterans' Hospital, Van Nuys, Cal., for checking progress of cancer patients.

West said the new method was as simple as a Wasserman blood test and would promptly detect any accelerated spread of malignancy or sudden development of resistance.

"This new check may help doc-

tors save many patients by catching the malignancy when it first crops out again, enabling them to cope with it before it gets out of control," he said.

Previously, the only method of determining the effectiveness of cancer treatment was how long the patient lived after the treatment. Frequently, malignancy cropped out again in the patient and got out of control before the patient was aware of it.

Red Cross Moves To Temporary Offices

All chapter business will be conducted there for several weeks until remodeling of a portion of the building is completed.



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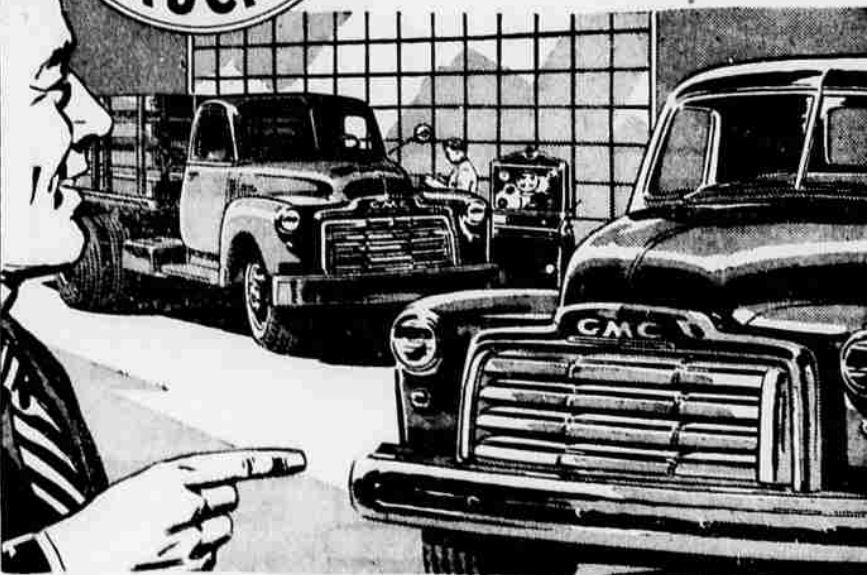
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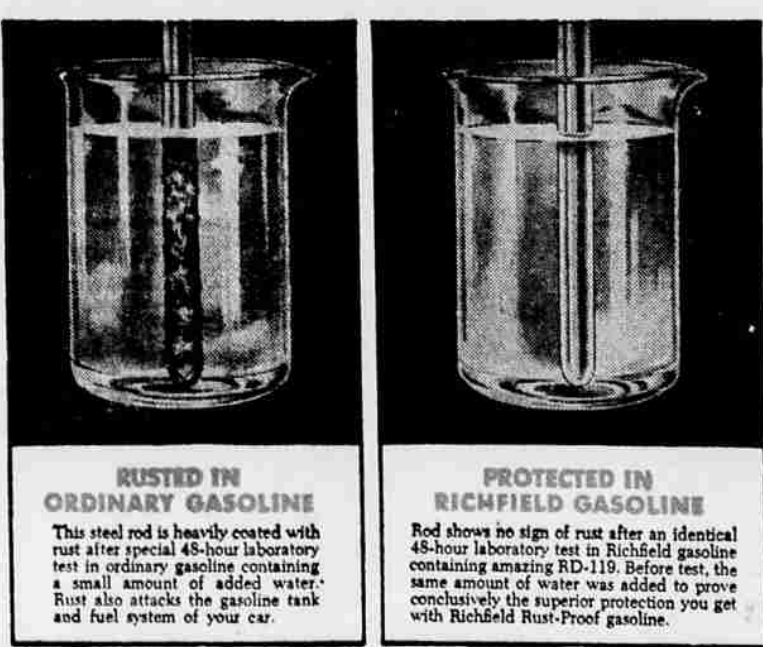
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
