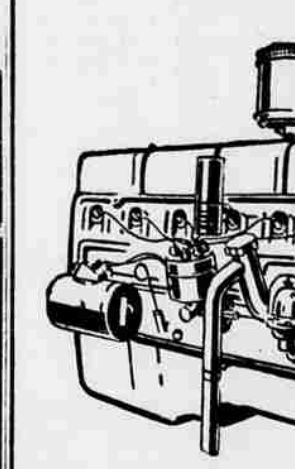

SEARCH FOR VITAMIN B-12... The search for what turned out to be Vitamin B-12 started years ago by a diabetic Boston doctor who had been saving the new wonder drug of that time, Insulin.
