### **REFRIGERATOR COOKIES**

4 cups sifted enriched flour,  
 1 teaspoon salt,  
 1 teaspoon cream of tartar  
 1 teaspoon soda  
 2/3 cup lard  
 2 cups brown sugar  
 2 eggs  
 1 cup chopped nuts  
 Sift together flour, salt, cream of tartar and soda. Cream lard and sugar thoroughly. Add eggs and blend well. Combine sifted

dry ingredients and nuts; add to creamed mixture and mix thoroughly. Shape the dough into 2 or 3 rolls, 1 1/2 inches in diameter; wrap in wax paper and chill in refrigerator over night. Cut into 1/8 inch slices, and bake in moderately hot oven (400 degrees F.) 6 to 8 minutes or until lightly browned. Yield: 9 dozen cookies.
