Narcotics Chief Reports More Cocaine in US

WASHINGTON — (AP) — "Extremely disturbing" increases in the smuggling of the drug cocaine into the United States are reported by the Narcotics Bureau.

Up to now, it said, there had not been any considerable traffic in cocaine, or the use of it, in this country.

In a report on "traffic in opium and other dangerous drugs" during 1948, the bureau said:

Regular Smuggling

"Quite reliable information is at hand indicating that cocaine is available in large quantities in Peru, Chile, and Bolivia, and that American seamen are smuggling it regularly to the United States."

"In the Harlem district of New York City there appears to be sufficient cocaine available to satisfy demands in the illicit traffic and it is indicated that a portion of this cocaine is smuggled from Peru to out-of-the-way ports in South Carolina and Alabama and then transported overland to New York."

"Previously there had not existed in the United States any con-

siderable traffic in and use of cocaine."

The U. S. recently got from Peru a promise that steps would be taken to control the cocaine factories in that country so the drug would not be diverted into underworld channels in the U. S.

Shanghai, Rangoon, Calcutta and Singapore were described in the report as "hotbeds of narcotics activities" on the basis of advice the bureau said it obtained from incoming merchant seamen.

In detailing an increase in heroin seizures, the bureau observed there is "definite indication that the Far East is again a source of supply of heroin."

Three Band Members Fired After Charges

DETROIT, Mich. — (AP) — Jazz drummer Gene Krupa said Thursday he had hired the three members of his band arrested on narcotics charges.

Krupa, involved in a similar case six years ago, said he had fired the men under a clause in their contracts forbidding "unbecoming conduct and the use of stimulants."

"I've been speaking to the boys about their conduct," he told police. "This is certainly a painful experience, especially since I've got two strikes on me already."

The band members arrested are guitar player Ralph Blaze, 27, of Weehawken, N.J.; Herbert Randle, 28, of Richmond Hill, N.Y., and John P. Bello, 22, of Paterson, N.J.

All three pleaded guilty to illegal possession of narcotics and Federal Judge Arthur Lederle set Sept. 12 for their sentencing. They face possible maximum sentences of five years imprisonment and \$5000 fines each.

Explosive Problem

Seamstresses Strike

PARIS — (AP) — France's fashion industry was hit this week by a strike of 14000 seamstresses.

The girls are asking boosts of from 15 to 30 francs (four to nine cents) an hour in their wages, which vary from 60 to 95 francs hourly (18 to 28 cents).

First indications were that the strike would not halt the fall fashion showings, about to get underway. Most of the new clothes are ready.



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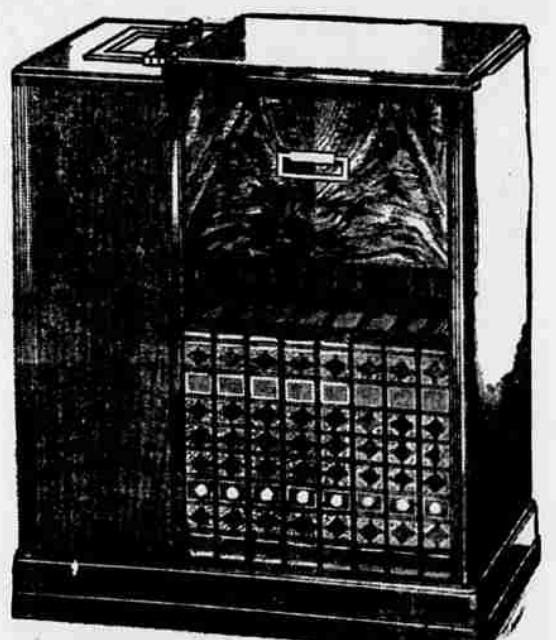
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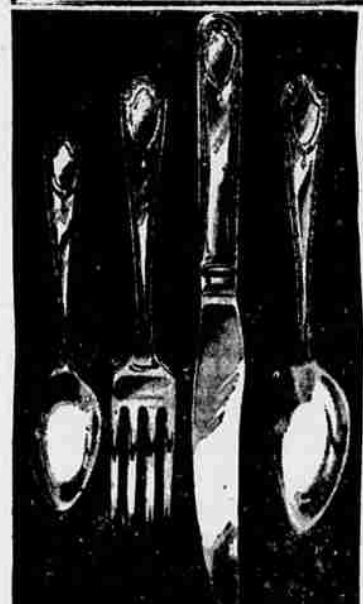
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
