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Grass Burning Care Advised

State Farm Forester A. H. Sasser reported Monday that his office had not stopped issuing burning permits during the recent hot weather, but that he was advising persons wishing to burn grass and rubbish to be extremely careful.

Some pointers:
Burn only if absolutely necessary to get rid of a fire hazard.

Burn in small piles, carefully isolated from other combustible material.

Burn early in the morning before the wind rises, and in quantities that will be burned out before the wind comes up later in the day.

Before starting any fire, contact your appropriate fire prevention agency, such as the East or West Lane Fire Patrol, city fire marshal, or the various fire protection districts. In cases where the fire department has a telephone, be sure and call the number listed for some member of the fire department, rather than the department number, which in most cases sets off a neighborhood alarm.

14 Iron Lungs To West Coast

Fourteen new iron lungs, purchased with \$28,000 of March of Dimes Funds and consigned to the Portland emergency equipment pool of the National Foundation for Infantile Paralysis, have been added to the Pacific Coast's polio-fighting arsenal, it was announced in Portland.

Ten of the respirators were shipped to Los Angeles and two were sent to Boise, according to Felix Montes, and foundation's Oregon representative. The two remaining machines have been placed in the Portland pool warehouse but Montes expressed the belief that they might be called into Idaho's epidemic area in the near future. The Portland pool, as permanent repository for polio equipment earmarked for common use in Far Western states, will house all 14 respirators at times when they are not needed.

Other Equipment.
In addition, Montes said, the foundation's Portland storehouse has custody of a portable iron lung, several hotpack machines, wool for hotpacks, an autoclave, sterilizer and hospital beds. Some of this equipment has just been received from Malheur county, where it was employed in the 1947 infantile paralysis outbreaks.

Including the two new machines in the pool and four new ones recently purchased by the foundation's Multnomah county chapter, there are now 14 respirators in the state—one each in LaGrande, Eugene, Astoria, and Oregon City and the balance in Portland, Montes revealed.

No Emergency
"The 10 shipped to Los Angeles were not needed to cope with an immediate emergency," Montes said. "Cases are building up steadily in Southern California but, as yet, it is not an emergency area. Idaho, of course, is in more serious straits."

As for Oregon, board of health figures showed four new cases for the week ended July 23, for a total for the year of 59, as compared with 32 at the same time in 1948. Two of the new cases were counted in Multnomah county and one each in Lane and Marion counties.

Superior Judge Renz L. Jennings granted the divorce on Mrs. Boettiger's cross-complaint charging "wilful desertion." Boettiger's original suit, claiming "extreme mental cruelty" was lost by de-

fault when he failed to answer his wife's cross-complaint within 20 days as prescribed by Arizona law.

The divorce was the second in the Roosevelt family within the past two months. Franklin D. Roosevelt, Jr., was divorced by his heiress wife, Ethel Dupont, in Carson City, Nev., a few days after he was elected to Congress from New York.

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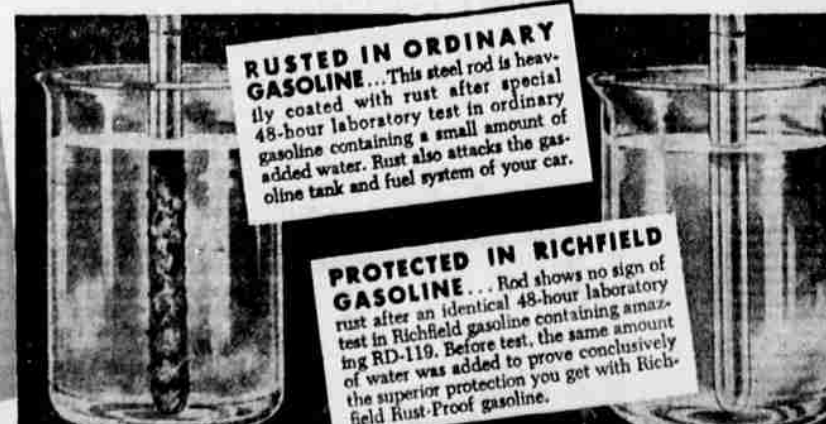
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
