Bogus Money Agent Held

NEW YORK — (AP) — A 52-year-old grandmother, said to be the liaison agent for a \$1 million counterfeit ring working out of New York, surrendered to federal authorities Tuesday.
After her surrender, Mrs. Beatrice Resch engaged in a hair-pulling match in the U. S. Attorney's office with another woman who allegedly informed on her. Secret service agents had to pull Mrs. Resch away from Lillian Mizell, 37-year-old plump brunette who is serving a three-year jail sentence for belonging to the counterfeit ring.

Held in Jail
Mrs. Resch, wife of an invalid, was held in \$5,000 bail on a charge of conspiracy to violate counterfeit laws. Her attorney, Louis Kaye, termed the charge against her "a lot of poetry."

The U. S. Attorney's office charged that she was sent to Connecticut by leaders of the New York gang to offer "perfect" money from new plates for exclusive circulation in that state if the Connecticut ring would buy \$50,000 worth.

Assistant U. S. Attorney Roy M. Cohn said the New York gang decided to push money into Connecticut when things got "too hot" here. He did not know if any of the phone currency was delivered to Connecticut buyers.

Contact Agent

Federal authorities said that Mrs. Resch was a contact agent for the gang allegedly headed in New York by Michael Malone, who was arrested last week. He has been unable to raise \$50,000 bail. At the time of his arrest Malone was described as the "East Coast king pin" of a gang which had distributed several million dollars worth of phony bills and three-cent stamps across the nation in recent months. The gang allegedly sold fake money to wholesalers for \$8 to \$15 per \$100.

Navy Medals Ready Now

Navy Occupation Service Medals and Claps, and China Service Medals are now available for distribution for all eligible ex-Coast Guardsmen and ex-U. S. Public Health Service personnel who served with the Coast Guard during World War II, it was announced by the 13th Coast Guard District Headquarters today.

These medals may be obtained by appearing in person at:
(a) USCG Recruiting Office, Seattle, Washington.
(b) USCG Recruiting Office, Spokane, Washington.
(c) Marine Inspection Office, Portland, Oregon.
(d) USCG Air Station, Port Angeles, Washington.
(e) USCG Group, Yaquina Bay, Oregon.

Each person must bring his discharge certificate, form NAVCG-533 "Notice of Separation from the U. S. Naval Service - Coast Guard" or other official proof of eligibility for these awards. If a personal appearance is not practicable, a written request inclosing such proof may be addressed to the Commandant (PMM), U. S. Coast Guard Headquarters, Washington 25, D. C.

Navy Specialist Out To Save Fish Life

ST. JOHN'S, Nfld. — (AP) — A youthful United States Navy reserve commander is plying the Newfoundland and Labrador coasts, making sure fish got enough to eat before being eaten themselves.

Cmdr. David C. Nutt, USNR, 30-year-old Arctic specialist who in 1944 was the youngest commander in the U. S. Navy, is doing research work in marine biology in the research vessel Blue Dolphin.

Aided by a grant from the Arctic Institute of North America, he is investigating the extent and growth of plankton, a group of small sea organisms, in the area where Labrador, Greenland and the Gulf Stream meet.

"All other marine life is dependent upon plankton," he explained. "So that there be a good supply of fish, plankton must be available as food."

He said he hoped his studies would result in sufficient fish food to feed fish that later would be caught and sold in markets on the

Canadian and United States mainland.

"Marine life," he said, "is directly influenced by these ocean currents, is of critical importance not only from a scientific point of view. It is also important with its far-reaching economic effect in the seal, cod, and former whale fisheries, and upon the native populations along the coastal area who wrest their livelihood from the sea."
