

## Shean Stone Will Carry Famous Line

NEW YORK—(P)—The trademark line — "Absolutely, Mr. Gallagher? Positively, Mr. Shean"—that Al Shean helped make famous in life will be inscribed on his tombstone.

Lawrence Shean, son of the 81-year-old actor disclosed that the famed trouper had directed this epitaph be placed on the stone:

Born May 12, 1868. I could have lived longer, but now it's too late. Absolutely, Mr. Gallagher? Positively, Mr. Shean."

Shean, who died Friday, was buried after services at Riverside Memorial Chapel.

Jones pointed out that removal of Willamette from the system would either throw an unbalanced load on the main north-south street or would necessitate a whole new system.

If Willamette were a two-way street, he explained, it would throw a five-to-one burden on the main street. He pointed out that the three central streets (Oak, Willamette and Olive) would then carry five lanes of north-bound traffic and only one lane of south bound traffic. This distribution is made more equitable (five to five) when Charnelton and Pearl are considered. Chief Jones admitted, but said that the two outer streets are too far from Willamette to relieve the burden there.

He objected to confusing the public with too many changes. City Manager King emphasized that any changes in the system would be effected only to work out a good permanent system, and that in no case would the city make a practice of frequent changes in the system.

Wedding rings were made of iron in early Roman times.

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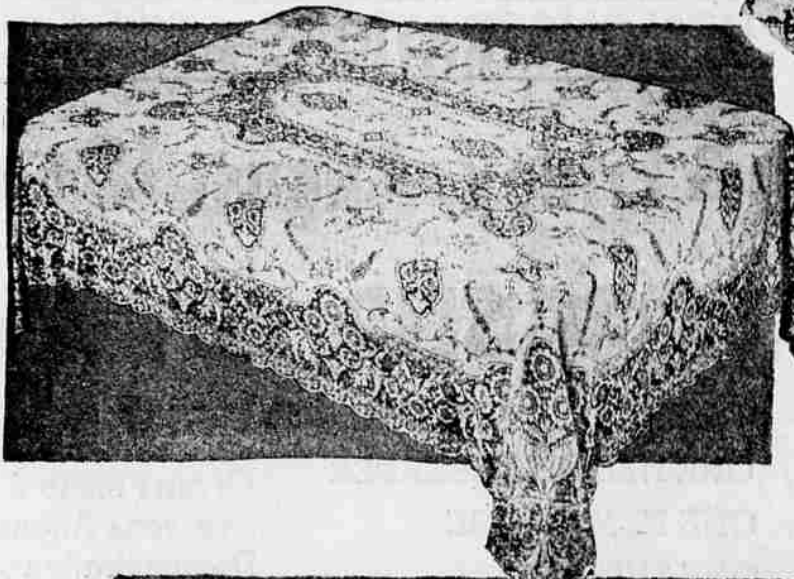

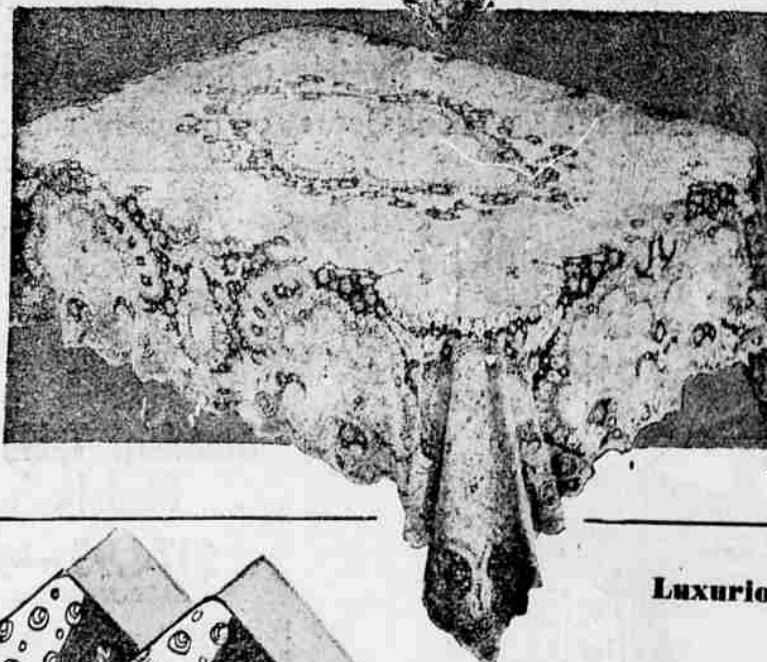
