Agents Accuse Eight of Being In Gold Ring

LOS ANGELES—(AP)—Federal secret service agents have accused six men and two women, who assertedly possessed \$48,000 of illegal gold, of being members of an international ring that smuggled gold into this country from Mexico.

In a raid on the Pasadena home of Everett David Grose, 63, federal agents confiscated 1000 ounces of gold.

Grose, Dr. Mark Ellsworth Roby, 57, San Diego, Cal., a dentist, his wife, Jane, 51; Clarence Blazier, 72; Frederick Stephen Kearney, 53; painting contractor Horace Newby, 46, all of San Diego; and Guy William Bates, 51, and his wife Eva, of Nogales, Ariz., were arrested.

Hoarding and Profiting

They were accused of conspiracy in connection with hoarding and profiting in gold.

Through the help of Louis Harrison, a dealer in mining and assaying equipment, the government agents had kept watch on him eight. Harrison said he was approached several months by a man who offered to sell illegal gold. Pretending interest, he informed authorities and said he was told "the stuff is ready."

He went to Grose's home, ac-

panied by four government men posing as buyers. The gold, for which the group was assertedly asking \$50 an ounce, was piled on a table.

Federal authorities believed the eight are members of a gang operating in the United States, Canada and Mexico.

Blazier, who operated a gambling ship off Long Beach until closed down by the government in 1928, denied he and Newby were involved in smuggling.

"We are victims of circumstances," he claimed. "We don't know anything about any illegal gold. We'll be cleared when the facts come out."

Secret service agents reportedly accompanied by Mrs. Roby were to search Dr. Roby's home in San Diego.

Robeson Called At Red Trial

NEW YORK—(AP)—Singer Paul Robeson testified 20 minutes for the defense Tuesday in the Communist conspiracy trial.

But about all he got to say was that he knew all the defendants—and that he once studied law under Federal Judge Harold R. Medina, who is presiding at the trial.

The government objected to virtually everything else the Negro baritone was asked, and Medina upheld the objections.

A climax came when Defense Counsel George W. Crockett Jr. also a Negro, inquired of Robeson.

"I think you shared a platform once with President Roosevelt," objection, said U. S. Attorney John F. X. McGohey.

Sustained, said Medina.

The judge added that Crockett seemed to be trying to establish facts even though the questions were being ruled out.

Whether Robeson did or didn't share a platform with the late President, Medina said, has nothing to do with the case.

Crockett said that in view of the rulings he found it impossible to get the testimony he wanted from Robeson.

"I don't think you should have called him," Medina commented.

Robeson left the stand a few minutes later after McGohey said he didn't wish to cross-examine. The witness, an outspoken ad-

mirer of the Soviet Union, testified that he once studied law under Medina at Columbia University.

Robeson told an impromptu news conference immediately afterward:

"My reaction is that they don't want the truth."

By "they" he apparently meant Medina and the prosecution.

Robeson said he had hoped to testify that "the Communist Party has played a magnificent role in fighting for the freedom of the American Negro."

Czechs Make More Arrests

PRAGUE—(AP)—The Czechoslovak government has jailed dozens of Roman Catholic priests and nuns in a big new wave of arrests aimed at breaking spreading resistance to state control schemes, a statement from church sources said Tuesday.

An informed church source estimated that the latest wave of arrests brought the number of Catholic priests under arrest to more than 200.

No Comment

No official comment was available on these figures. The government usually does not announce arrests of priests until they have been sentenced. However, the Czech press has recently carried an increasing number of threats against priests who carry out "anti-state" orders issued from the Vatican and the church hierarchy.

The report, given to correspondents here and enumerating at least 30 arrests, was termed only a partial list. It said more arrests were expected as the low-state-church fight neared a showdown stage.

In one case the entire personnel of a monastery was reported seized.

The government has published a proposed church law, to be enacted by parliament this fall, which would give the state power over all church appointments and administration.

Meanwhile reports reached Prague that a local Communist official had been killed by angry peasants in Moravia following the arrests of a Catholic priest.

The news stirred speculation whether fresh peasant uprisings are brewing.

An official source at the Moravian town of Kelo, scene of the reported incident, confirmed the slaying. He said a big squad of security police have been moved into the town to investigate the case.
