

### Blue Are Thinned Death of Aged Vets

BRANCH, Cal.—The ranks of the blue were thinned with the death of peppery little Charles L. Chappel, 102, who realized his lifetime ambition to be national commander of the Civil War died at the Naval hospital in a few hours after an ambulance brought him from his home in a semi-conscious condition.

Chappel had been suffering from a long illness since he was 80. He was the last national commander of the Grand Army of the Republic at Indianapolis. He was an elderly veteran, failed miserably because of the illness to become national commander of the organization. Chappel was succeeded by Commander Fred L. Peck, 100, of Portland.

### Wholesale Sales Shows Big Drop

NEW YORK — (AP) — The Dun & Bradstreet wholesale food price index dropped 13 cents in the week which ended Tuesday. It was the widest break in more than seven months.

The drop cut the index to \$5.72, lowest since July 19, and wiped out most of a net gain of 19 cents since the index started rising on July 12. This week last year, the index stood at \$6.82.

Breaks in the prices of edible oils and declines in grain and livestock markets were largely responsible for the big drop. The previous widest decline was a drop of 22 cents in the week ended Feb. 8.

Of the 31 foods used in compiling the index, 17 moved downward, 11 were unchanged, and three increased. The index is the sum total of the wholesale price per pound of each.

The commodities which declined were flour, wheat, corn, rye, oats, barley, hams, lard, cottonseed oil, cocoa, beans, rice, steers, hogs, lambs and butter.

Unchanged were cheese, sugar, tea, peas, peanuts, eggs, molasses, currants, prunes, milk and raisins.

Those which advanced were beef, hog bellies and potatoes.

### Turkey Growers Talk 'Supports'

CORVALLIS — (AP) — Oregon Turkey Improvement Assn. members were told Tuesday to work for elimination of weight discrimination in federal price supports.

W. T. Geurts, retiring president, said the existing regulations were unfair to producers of heavy birds. He said any permanent farm legislation should place turkeys on the same parity price percentage basis as wheat and other basic crops.

Elected president for the new year was W. H. Schwedler, Portland. Les Schneider, Medford, was elected a new director. Re-elected as directors were Loren Johnson, Scappoose and Paul McCowell, Sherwood. Noel Benning, Oregon State College, was re-elected secretary-treasurer.

Several turkey project aides at the Oregon State Experimental Station spoke. Dr. Paul Bernier, geneticist, said selective breeding falls into two classes. He said all breeders can mass select for maximum weight and maturity in the shortest feeding time. But selection for higher fertility, egg production and other characteristics was best left to breeders of pedigreed birds, he said.

COLO. — (AP) — The attorney charged a 20-year-old Denver mother with Wednesday for slapping her illegitimate 10-year-old baby so violently that she died.
