Gold Discovery Called 'Fraud'

CAPETOWN, South Africa—(AP)—The fabulous Orfdel gold discovery, which touched off a \$10 million stock boom last June, was a fraud and the perpetrators are being sought, the South African government said Wednesday.

A government statement said the ore samples, which showed a world record strike of 529 ounces of gold per ton of ore, were "fraudulently increased before it was assayed."

The find was reported June 3 and shares of the company which owned the area, the Free State Gold Mines, jumped from \$2.80 to \$11.40. Tuesday's quotation was \$1.89.

A test bore, taken under police supervision, showed only two ounces of gold per ton.

Basin Projects Funds Needed, Group Reports

SALEM—(AP)—The Willamette River Basin Commission would like to see planning funds made available in the next fiscal year for the Green Peter Dam on the South Santiam River and the Cougar Dam on the McKenzie.

The commission, meeting here, said that both of the proposed electric power and flood control dams deserve prompt attention.

Chairman Ronald Jones of Brooks, Ore., and Secretary Ivan Oakes of Salem said it takes two to three years to complete planning and obtain a construction appropriation for a project.

Members of the commission estimated that the Dorena Dam will be completed this fall, Detroit Dam in 1952 and Meridian Dam in 1954. The members expressed fear that there would be a lull in dam construction activity in the Willamette Basin unless planning funds are allocated the following fiscal year.

Oakes announced that the dedication of Dorena Dam on Row River seven miles southeast of Cottage Grove is set for Oct. 23. Speakers will include Goy, Douglas McKay, Congressman Harris Ellsworth (R-Ore.) and Col. O. E. Walsh of Portland, north Pacific division engineer.

The commission approved several drainage meetings. The first will be held at Eugene Jan. 10, covering Lane County. Other meetings include:

Linn and Benton Counties, at Albany, Jan. 11.
Marion and Polk Counties at Salem, Jan. 12.
Washington County at Hillsboro, Jan. 18.
Yamhill County at McMinnville or Newberg, Jan. 19.

Vaughan's White House Role Nothing New to Army Aide

WASHINGTON — (AP) — The influential role of Maj. Gen. Harry Vaughan in the Truman administration is nothing new for military aides to Presidents.

Vaughan has been hot front page material in recent weeks because of his friendship for and assistance to key figures in the current Senate investigation of so-called "five per centers."

Probably no one in government today is closer to the President than Vaughan, a reserve officer who first met Mr. Truman in the Missouri National Guard after World War I in which both served as artillerymen.

Vaughan has the President's ear whenever he wants it. His duties, according to his own testimony before the Senate investigators, go far beyond the simple liaison functions of one of three armed services aides at the White House. He does, to put it simply, what the President asks, and sometimes more. He is paid a major general's salary of \$10,744 a year.

The historical fact is that this has been going on for years. Military aides in a number of administrations have occupied powerful

roles of influence. Several became ambassadors. Many served as presidential secretaries concurrently with their duties as aides.

Brig. Gen. Horace Porter, for example, served as aide and private secretary to President Grant. He became so popular for finding the grave of John Paul Jones in France that Congress gave him the privilege of the floor of both Houses for life. Maj. Archibald Butt, aide to Presidents Taft and Theodore Roosevelt, was noted in Washington for his influence, particularly in the administration of "TR."

Rank Usual

Vaughan's rank as a major general is not without precedent. The Army aide to the late President Franklin D. Roosevelt was Maj. Gen. Edwin M. (Pa) Watson who also served for several years as the President's appointment secretary.

Watson's secretarial role was one of considerable power because to a large extent, he exercised control over Mr. Roosevelt's daily list of callers. Watson was at the side of F.D.R. at all the important wartime conferences and

died en route home from Yalta in 1945.

A number of Presidents gave their military aides a choice plum on the side—the job of superintendent of public buildings and grounds in the District of Columbia. As a matter of fact, this was the custom rather than an exception from the early nineties until the time of President Coolidge.

The overall White House staff is smaller today than it was during the later years of the Roosevelt administration. But the aides still blossom in profusion when the social season comes around. Actually, a score or more of smartly uniformed young men known as "aides" will be on hand for a big White House party. These men serve only at social functions, and for many years have made many feminine hearts flutter with their martial color and courtly manners.

Accused Judge Is Acquitted

ATLANTA — (AP) — Judge Robert Carpenter, acquitted of shooting the man he charged with the "Judah" act of attempting to ruin him and take his wife, has returned to the bench but still has legal problems of his own.

Carpenter was found not guilty of blaring away at his one-time best friend, Attorney John Lockwood. A 12-man superior court jury deliberated only 58 minutes before making its decision.

The courtroom full of spectators who had hung on every word of testimony in the six-day trial burst into spontaneous applause when the verdict was announced.

Carpenter, suspended from judicial duties after the charge was made against him, is to resume his bench in the Civil Court of Fulton County. He is still involved in a welter of suits, including a divorce action filed by the wife his defense accused of more-than-friendly relations with Lockwood.

The attorney who lost nearly all sight in one eye when Carpenter fired at him, was warned of possible disbarment proceedings.
