OPEN HOUSE: The Fire Department will hold open house at the Main Station and the two sub-stations Saturday following the bicycle parade.

The greatest contribution you can make toward preventing fires, is to make sure that your home . . . your car . . . your place of business, is safe!

"FLAMEPROOF YOUR FUTURE"

- CHECK:** Have fireplace screen to check sparks
- CHECK:** Watch for breaks or wear in lamp and appliance cords
- CHECK:** Be sure electrical circuits are sufficient to carry peak loads. Consult a good electrician
- CHECK:** Snuff matches carefully. Don't throw them in waste baskets, garbage pails or wood boxes.
- CHECK:** Guard against spontaneous ignition fires by keeping any necessary oily rags (furniture polish, wax, paint, etc.) in closed metal container . . . and not in closed closet or cupboard
- CHECK:** Don't throw flour, uncooked cereal or vacuum cleaner dust in stove with fire. It is explosive.
- CHECK:** Don't leave small children at home unattended or with an irresponsible person.
- CHECK:** Don't light matches in closets
- CHECK:** Clean up your basement and keep it clean. Many fires start in basement or attic litter
- CHECK:** Keep heating plant and chimney clean and in good repair so they will not throw off sparks.
- CHECK:** Soot in chimney and heater should be removed at least annually
