

## May and Garssons Hope for Hearing

WASHINGTON — (AP) — Former Rep. Andrew J. May (D-Ky) a key legislator during World War II, still clinging to the faint hope that the Supreme Court might still save him from a prison cell.

Warren E. Magee, attorney for the 74-year-old wartime chairman of the House Military Affairs Committee, said he intends to ask the court to reconsider its decision which, in effect, upheld the 1947 bribery convictions of May and the Garsson brothers, Murray M. and Henry W.

The high court announced its ruling Monday. Ordinarily it could take about 10 days for it to notify the local district court of its action—the move that would lead to the trio's almost immediate commitment.

But if the Supreme Court agrees to halt up this notification so that May can file a petition of reconsideration, he will be as-

ured of perhaps another month of freedom.

"If May goes to prison, the chances are that his age and failing health would entitle him to special consideration."

May has informed the court that a prison term would ruin the "life-long reputation" he built up in his climb from humble beginnings in the Kentucky backwoods to an influential post in Congress.

May and the Garssons are now free on \$2500 bond each. They have been sentenced to serve from eight months to two years in prison for their part in a bribery conspiracy in which May received \$53,000 from the Garssons in return for his influence with the War Department in behalf of their giant munitions combine.

## Eugene Men Two Plaintiffs In Mine Suit

ANCHORAGE, Alaska — (AP) — The name of Nick Bez, Pacific Northwest fishing fleet operator and close friend of President Truman, figures prominently in the trial of a \$90,000 mining suit in Third District Court.

Bez was referred to several times by Al Schneider, member of an Oregon group suing P. J. Cutting and Audrey Cutting of the Kougarok Dredging Corp., in an effort to break a mining agreement.

Among the plaintiffs are Earl and John McNutt, Eugene contractors and builders. Earl McNutt is a former mayor of Eugene and a member of the state legislature.

Schneider, general manager of Oregon Motor Stages, Portland, testified in his fourth straight day on the stand that Bez was consulted by a group of Oregon financiers before they advanced \$70,000 to the Kougarok Dredging Corp., to be used in purchasing stock in adjacent placer property on the Kougarok River, known as Kougarok Consolidated Placers, Inc.

The Oregonians were identified as E. Royce, Schneider, Douglas Owens, Charles Stearns, and the McNutt brothers.

They are suing to cancel a contract they entered into with the Kougarok Dredging Corp., on the grounds that its president, P. J. Cutting, did not inform them as to the financial obligations of the firm.

The Cuttings filed a counterclaim, charging the Oregonians breached the contract by evicting them from gold mining premises and by other arbitrary actions.

Schneider testified Bez told him that Kougarok Consolidated Placer was a good investment. Wendell Kay, attorney for the Oregon men, said that Bez was a large stockholder in the Nome area placer firm.

Royce is identified as president of Oregon Motor Stages and part-owner in the Yellow Cab Co., in Seattle and Portland; and Stearns and Owens as partners in a heavy construction firm at Medford, Ore.
