

Grove Sewer Jobs Progress

Construction Crews Defy Dampness

COTTAGE GROVE—Construction of sewer projects was making rapid headway here Friday in spite of damp weather.

City Recorder Don Allen said 700 feet of sewer line has already been installed along North 10th St. Crews of E. N. Dolan & Co., Portland, Friday were excavating along Highway 99 north of Main St. Installations of a trunk line sewer along South 10th St. will start shortly.

To Cost \$10,000
These three sewer projects will cost approximately \$10,000: (1) South 10th St. trunk sewer, (2) South 10th St. lateral sewer, (3) South 9th and 10th Sts. lateral sewers.

Meanwhile, city crews are completing an extensive drainage project designed to eliminate heavy water that floods the city's southeastern section each year.

Ditch Deepened

A ditch that runs from 12th and Madison in a westerly direction to the city limits and 6th St. is being deepened to handle surface water. Drainage tile is also being installed to help carry the water into the Coast Fork of the Willamette River north of Cottage Grove.

The entire drainage project will cost the city about \$10,000. The work will be financed through the sewer sinking fund.

When J. Hartley Manners wrote "Peg O' My Heart" 40 years ago, he certainly had someone like Miss Florence Hawkesworth in mind for the role of "Peg."

In any case, Miss Hawkesworth plays the part of the pert, saucy, witty and brutally honest Irish miss as though the role were created for her. "Peg O' My Heart," opened Thursday night at VLT, and continues through Oct. 28, with the exception of Monday, Oct. 22.

Miss Hawkesworth, small, vivacious and blonde, has appeared in other VLT productions including "Dear Ruth," and "Suppressed Desire." She is superb with her Irish accent in "Peg."

Miss Hawkesworth is generally well supported in the play which concerns an uppity-up British family which suddenly finds itself broke, and, at the same time, saved from financial distress by the will of a rich relative which specifies that the arrogant Chichesters care for another relative, Peg.

Peg admits she's the proverbial "sow's ear" from which silk purses cannot be made, but demonstrates that she has a heart of gold.

John Poul, who last appeared in "Elizabeth the Queen," is very good as the loose-jointed, nonchalant, lazy son of the idle rich, Chichesters.

Acting honors, too, are shared by the VLT veterans, Mrs. Sylvia Cuthbert, as the selfish mother of the Chichester household; by Mrs. Peg Roark as the daughter, and Robert Nelson, as Jerry, the titled neighbor who saves the day, and wins Peg.

Mrs. Cuthbert last was seen in "There's Always Juliet." Mrs. Roark appeared last in "Rhythmmania," Robert Nelson appears for the first time on VLT stage, after successful parts with University Theater, the latest in "Mary of Scotland."

Jack Logan, who has had experience with Portland theater groups, is making his debut with VLT, as Brent, Ethel Chichester's suitor. On opening night he could have been more deliberate in his acting and speech.

Dwight Newman, always dependable, took the part of the family lawyer, Robert Nicols, as the footman, and Bea Perin as the maid, were convincing; got their share of laughs.

The two canine actors were good, too. "Michael" the mongrel, was borrowed from the Humane Society, and needs a home after the show closes. The "society" dog was played by Dwight Newman's "Tyke."

Muslims in Singapore rioted last Dec. 11 after a British court awarded custody of the Muslim-reared girl to her Roman Catholic Dutch mother. The rioters killed 19 persons and injured 290.

Democracy's Future in Europe Subject of Little Town Hall

Four Eugene residents who spent part or all of the summer abroad will be speakers on the first of a series of YMCA Little Town Hall programs Thursday Oct. 25 at 8 p.m. at First Congregational Church.

Taking part in a discussion on "What is the Future for Democracy in Western Europe?" will be Dr. Gordon Wright, professor of history at the University of Oregon; Dr. John Kirk, M.D., local physician; Wesley G. Nicholson, minister of the Congregational Church; and Ben Neilson, Eugene lumberman.

The program, as always, will be free and open to the public. Dr. John Tysell, chairman of the YMCA Little Town Hall Committee, said the policy of open forum discussion following the short talks will be continued on Little Town Hall programs this year. Robert Clark, of the university speech department, will be moderator.

After the program, refreshments will be served all guests. Dr. Tysell said that the speakers will attempt to answer audience questions about special problems in the areas of Europe in which they visited.

"The YMCA offers the Little Town Hall discussions as a public service," Dr. Tysell explained. "Our audiences have been growing steadily, as more people realize that the meetings are public. We want everyone interested to turn out."

His Map Aids Mail Carrier

FAIRMONT, W. Va.—(AP)—A soldier in Korea who received four letters back stamped, "insufficient address," found his own cure for the situation.

Earl F. Needham, of Pliny, W. Va., had left an "Americanism" citation in a bookstore here to be framed. Before it was completed he was shipped to Korea.

A letter was written to Holt's Office Supply requesting the citation be forwarded to Korea. The first letter was returned, followed by Earl's three other letters without reaching their destination.
