

## Council Approves Permit Under Fire

STAGE GROVE—The large council of the year—some 70 in all—met last night in a special session to approve a permit for a liquor license application for a new restaurant. The council voted 4-2 to approve the permit.

The "great debate" lasted 45 minutes as several ministers and people protested an application by Fred Knickerbocker, owner of the Grove Tavern, for a liquor license. Several people supported Knickerbocker's request.

Rev. William Sutterlin, of the Baptist Church, "We are not in the business of selling liquor," but we are in the business of selling this for the welfare of the community. In our opinion, to the license would allow the owner of the saloon to come back and sell a man's right to a matter of life and death, but a matter of life and death.

Anderson, proprietor of Quality Market, took an opposing view. He said:

Knickerbocker wouldn't operate unless it was on a license. I know people go to the bar and drink and I'm not that. But they can go to the store and buy all they want. As long as it is legal, I can't see what it would make things any worse.

After taking a final vote on the permit, councilmen were divided with a petition bearing signatures that urged the council to deny the permit. The board of the Methodist Church also submitted a letter urging denial of the permit.

The council then took its vote. Councilmen Joe Bricher, Z. A. Oscar Smith and Richard Smith approved the license. Elmer Kent voted against it.

Some of the audience then filed into the council chamber. A few returned when the council took action to approve the liquor license.

Some suggested the council take action on renewing the license for M and W Market, Club, and the Moose Lodge.

Bricher answered: "No one has asked these renewals for product of the licensee." He said there was no reason to deny the requests until another day. He then returned to the council's earlier action of approving the Grove Tavern license.

Bricher said: "There seems to be some misunderstanding as to the function of the council. We are not passing on the morals of those who want to drink. All we are doing is whether the establishment meets the demands of the law."

Frank Doleman then asserted the council's authority to exercise "rule" powers and can do more than follow steps outlined in state law.
