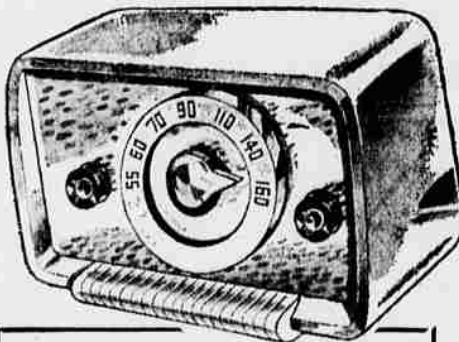

California Off-Street Parking

This is the second of a series of detailed reports on what California cities of various sizes have accomplished in municipal off-street parking. The statistics were compiled by the University of California's Bureau of Transportation and Traffic Engineering in cooperation with the League of California cities. Each table is a reprint from the magazine Western City's March issue. The final table will be a report on revenues received from various cities from their metered parking lots.

McCarthy a \$10,000 Man

Tydings Boosts Reward

WASHINGTON — (AP) — For Sen. Millard E. Tydings (D-Md.) increased from \$5000 to \$10,000 the reward for information leading to the arrest of Sen. Joseph McCarthy (R-Wis.) if McCarthy shows a grand jury evidence that he is a Communist in the Department. Tydings said he was "bitterly sarcastic" "open" and "got all these" "sent to jail." He said that two years have passed since McCarthy made the statement that he has proof there are Communists in the State Department.

Tydings headed a Senate subcommittee which investigated McCarthy's charges and labeled McCarthy a "fraud and a hoax." McCarthy struck back with charges Tydings "whitewashed" the McCarthy case, and also campaigned against Tydings in the Maryland election in 1946. Tydings was defeated for reelection.

Tydings said he abandoned the "disability theory" because he remembered that McCarthy resigned from the war and came back to Wisconsin just as the heavy fighting really was concluded. The \$5000 reward was too small.

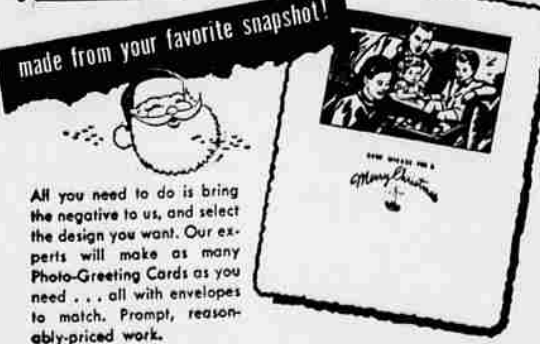
Tydings said that if McCarthy still does not go to the grand jury with his information, "some day when you are speaking to a group of legionnaires, a bucket of white-wash might be brought up on the platform and you would be charged with 'whitewashing' your own investigation."

"This ought not to happen to a patriot like you," Tydings said he would not be surprised if "some day we turn up one or two Communists" in the State Department. But, he added, "if any Communists are caught and exposed, it will be on evidence the FBI has developed, and not yours."

McCarthy has acknowledged receiving \$10,000 for a housing pamphlet he wrote for Lustron.
