Recorder Tells Tax Breakdown 45% of City's Dollar Goes to Police, Fire

COTTAGE GROVE — Some 45 per cent of the city's 1951-52 tax dollar goes for fire and police protection.

This was revealed in an annual report completed Tuesday by City Recorder Don Allen. Allen's statistics show where city revenue comes from and determine what percentage of the tax dollar is spent for each budgeted item.

Some 26 cents of each Cottage Grove 1951-52 tax dollar goes for city operation while 10 cents goes for the county and 64 cents for schools.

The city's total operating budget is \$108,834. Here is where this revenue comes from: Cash on hand, \$22,000; property tax levy, \$57,429; fines, \$10,000; permits and miscellaneous, \$2,503; licenses, \$1,000; franchises and fees, \$2,200; liquor revenue, \$15,000; state highway commission, \$16,000; parking meters, \$11,000; South Lane District, \$5,000.

The city plans to spend money to operate as follows: Administration and city hall, \$10,029 (nine per cent of city tax dollar); police protection, \$26,200 (24 per cent of tax dollar); fire department, \$22,930 (21 per cent); street and sewer maintenance and construction, \$22,875 (20.8 per cent); street paving (new construction), \$5,000 (4.5 per cent); street lights, \$4,300 (3.9 per cent).

Other items are disposal plant and sewers \$4,000 (3.65 per cent); street equipment, \$2,200 (2 per cent); city park, \$1,500 (1.35 per cent); library, \$4,800 (4.2 per cent); advertising, \$1,000 (.9 per cent); emergency fund, \$5,300 (4.75 per cent).

According to the report, a Cottage Grove homeowner whose house and lot is assessed at \$2,000 pays a city tax of \$41.80. This revenue will help pay for city services for 1951-52 as follows: Administration, \$3.90; police protection, \$9.10; fire protection, \$5.48; street and sewer maintenance, \$20.84; street lights, \$1.03; library, \$1.10; parks, 35 cents.

Garner Still Salty as Ever

UVALDE, Tex. — (AP) — John Nance Garner, still as salty a character as when he was vice president, will be 83 years old Thursday.

His main ambition is to live nine more years, to the age of 92. "Then I can say I spent half my life as a private citizen," said "Cactus Jack."

Garner spent 46 years in public office. Of these, 39 were spent in Washington—from 1902 when he first went to Congress until 1941 when he finished his second term as vice president and split with Franklin Delano Roosevelt over the third term issue.

He has no formula for longevity, except that "I smoke five or six good Mexican cigars a day, and have a little whiskey at night. Sometimes I have some in the morning, too."

Tropic Typhoon Sweeps Islands

MANILA — (AP) — A tropical typhoon swept a path of destruction through the central Philippines Wednesday. Planes were grounded, shipping disrupted and communications broken.

A Philippines air line plane left for the United States six hours ahead of schedule, to escape 60-mile-an-hour winds expected to hit Manila by Thursday.

The typhoon, with its torrential rains and 90-mile-an-hour winds, caused heavy damage to crops as it cut westward across Samar, Masbate and Romblon Islands. A weather bureau forecast indicated the center of the typhoon would strike the southern tip of Mindoro Island, 170 miles south of Manila, and pass on into the China Sea.

Texas Oilman Denies Signing Big Agreement

ROME, Italy — (AP) — Texas oilman Glenn McCarthy denied Tuesday reports in the Egyptian press that he has signed an agreement to invest \$10,000,000 in the National Petroleum Co. of Cairo.

He said the report sounded like "a plant" and did not contain "a word of truth." McCarthy and Johnny Meyer, assistant to millionaire Howard Hughes, leave for Paris by plane Tuesday.

Japanese Approve U. S. Security Pact

TOKYO — (AP) — Emperor Hirohito Monday signed the Japanese Peace Treaty and the U. S.-Japan Security Pact.

His signature, at Nara where he is on tour, completed Japanese action on the documents. The Diet gave its approval Sunday.

The United States Senate was expected to do likewise early next year. The pacts were agreed upon in September at San Francisco.

Adenauer Talks Set

PARIS — (AP) — West German Chancellor Konrad Adenauer arrived in Paris Tuesday for talks with the western Big Three foreign ministers. The German chancellor was accompanied by the U. S. High Commissioner in Germany, John J. McCloy.

Sears, Roebuck To Sell Autos

Agreement Reached With Kaiser-Frazer

DETROIT — (AP) — Sears, Roebuck and Co., which sells everything from girdles to fishing tackle, is going into the automobile business in a novel agreement with the Kaiser-Frazer Corp.

The huge mail order and department store chain and the nation's youngest car-maker announced that K-F will produce a low-priced car called the "Allstate" which will go on sale in 17 Sears stores by Christmas.

The new auto, in appearance, engineering and price will be much like K-F's 100-inch wheel-base Henry J, but it will have some distinguishing styling characteristics.

Specifications and prices of the new cars were not announced, but it was understood that K-F's more than 2800 dealers have been assured that Sears will not undercut them.

Advertised factory delivered prices of the Henry J. are \$1382 for the four-cylinder and model and \$1564 for the deluxe six.

North Korean Radio Reports UN Invasion

TOKYO (Wednesday) — (AP) — The North Korean radio said last night that Allied forces tried to invade the Ongjin Peninsula northwest of Seoul and were repulsed with the loss of three warships. There was no Allied confirmation.

A Communiqué broadcast by the Pyongyang radio did not say when the "invasion" was attempted. The peninsula has little military value, but the Allies have raided it on occasion in the past.

Large Shrimp Supply Found

PORTLAND — (U.P.) — Director of Fisheries Arnie J. Suomela said Wednesday the state fish commission was convinced the shrimp concentrations off the Oregon Coast were "sufficiently large for commercial fishing."

Suomela reported the shrimp bed lies off Cape Foulweather near Depoe Bay to the Columbia River in water 300 to 600 feet deep.

Experimental drags with a small net brought in 10 pounds of shrimp in a 15-minute sweep. "The shrimp were found in green mud on the ocean bottom," he said, "and are of the same species as the pink shrimp of Alaska."

No Injunction In Meat Case

PORTLAND — (U.P.) — The first of the Office of Price Stabilization suits against Oregon slaughterhouses ended this week in Portland without any action being taken.

Federal Judge James Alger Fee said he would not issue an injunction against the Singlehouse Slough Slaughterhouse, Coos Bay, and its operator, James Yocum, since the plant now apparently is complying with meat regulations.

Judge Fee warned, however, that the slaughterhouse would face an injunction against slaughtering if it should become delinquent in filing OPS reports.
