Under God's Guiding Hand

(A New Year's message from the president of the National Council of the Churches of Christ in the U.S.A., Henry Knox Sherrill, January issue of the NCC periodical, National Council Outlook.)

"It is a privilege to send a New Year's greeting to the members of the staff of the National Council and to all of our fellow workers and friends throughout the length and breadth of the land. With the New Year the Council will be entering its second year of life. On the whole, as we look back on 1951, we can be grateful, if not for spectacular results, certainly for steady progress in many fields and for mutual trust and goodwill, which is of greater importance.

"In a relationship so new and covering such a wide area, there were opportunities for division and disagreement. Of course there have been, and will continue to be problems, necessary discussion with frank differences of opinion. But I can testify that through the year, so far as I have observed, the Council has shown marked evidence of the unity of the spirit. I am deeply impressed with the quality and the devotion of the staff, secretaries, secretaries to the secretaries, and so on all along the line. We have reason to enter the second year with high hope.

"Certainly the coming year in a broader sense is bound to be eventful. With the world in the present tension, with the coming

political campaign and election, almost anything can happen for weal or woe. It is a time when the American people should face the situation with calm strength and courage rather than in anger, hysteria and fear. Experiences of crisis bring out the best and the worst in us. I believe that the nature of our times is deepening in our people a consciousness of their need of God. The coming of a new year with the manifold uncertainties emphasizes the transitoriness of the things of this world and at the same time gives us the strengthening assurance of the love of the Eternal God. It is not possible rightly, I think, in these days of widespread human suffering, to wish a Happy New Year. But we can, with a sense of the solemn trust of life, place ourselves under God's guiding hand, committing our ways to Him, so that whatever happens will mean a year of blessing, and that is my prayer for us all."
